Because we pay our dues at various times through the year I bet I am not the only one who forgot to apply for my SCGA multi-club discount for 2025. If you pay SCGA membership through more than one club you are entitled to a rebate of some or all of the SCGA dues you pay. SCGA dues are \$41, but the most you have to pay to SCGA regardless of the number of clubs you join is \$55. If you are a member of two clubs that means you may receive a rebate of \$27. SCGA dues will be rebated in full for any additional memberships after that.

I am a member of the Whispering Pines Golf Club, as are a number of you. That means I can get \$27 back for paying SCGA dues twice. Some of you are members of clubs at El Cariso or Knollwood, or the Disney club. If you paid SCGA dues through those other affiliations, you can get a rebate.

Fortunately, you (and I) can apply for the rebate anytime during the year. I just submitted mine as I sat down to write this article. Follow the link below for more details and to access the application form:
