4 - Man Scramble Step Aside (Modified Florida Format)

The following is a short overview. The complete 4-Man Scramble rules can be found on our website www.vvsmgc.info.

- You do not pick your partners. Teams are selected so that each team consists of one player from each of four flights. One "A" player, one "B", one "C" and one "D" player. This way the overall skill levels are nearly identical. We then use the Texas Scramble handicap calculator to establish the team handicap. The handicap calculator can be found on the web site Leaderboard.com
- All four players hit their tee shots. Next, the team picks the shot they like best. The remaining three players pick up their balls and place them next to the one selected. All players hit their next shots from that spot, **except the player whose tee shot is used, who "steps aside" and does not play the next shot. This procedure continues until the group is on the green, where all 4 players putt until the ball is holed.**
- The team must use at least four (4) tee shots from each player.
- Lift, clean and place rules are in effect for all shots, sort of like winter rules only better
- All players are eligible for all closest to the pins, inside the circle on #6, on the green drawing on #17, and any hole-in-one awards regardless if the shot is used for the team or not.
- **Please read the official rules** as they may stop a riot in your group. A good example is your team has a six foot putt for a birdie and you go first. You miss the putt and go up and tap it in. **Oops....big mistake!!!!** You should have marked it!!! The score is determined by first putt holed so the hole is now over. The rest of your team can no longer try for the birdie.
