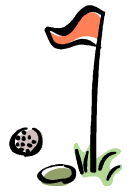

PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION & DISTRIBUTION

Prize Money - \$15.00 per player for home and away tournaments.

Tournament Winner Payouts – calculated from Home & Away Flight Payout Schedule.

Closest to the Pins - Home Tournaments will have 8 CTP'S as follows: Holes 5, 6, 8, 12, 13, 14, 17 and 18. Each will have a value of \$10 from the prize pool. Super Seniors (75 years and older) may pay an extra \$5 and be eligible for six designated Super Senior CTP's. The value of each will be the total money collected divided by the number of winners. The Super Senior CTP holes are currently holes 5, 6, 12, 13, 14 and 17. Selection of Super Senior CTP holes can be re-evaluated at the annual business meeting.

Closest to the Pins – Away Tournaments will have 4 CTP's with a value of \$20 each. The holes will be selected by the away Tournament Director and are traditionally the 4 shortest. Super Seniors will use the same holes as the seniors, and the value will be the total monies collected (\$5 each) divided by the number of winners.

Skins – Skins in our tournaments are defined as a single birdie on a hole in a particular flight. If a second player in his flight should also get a birdie on the same hole, it erases the skin. The value of each skin is determined as follows: from the prize money, \$2 per player is placed in the skins prize pool. Example: 40 players @ \$2 = \$80 prize pool. The total skins from all flights would then be divided into the prize pool (\$80 prize pool / 6 skins = \$13.33 payout for each skin.) All birdies on the scorecard must be circled so they are easily recognized by the tournament director. If you have a birdie, make sure it is highlighted. Skins are the same for both home and away tournaments.

Shootouts - This is a voluntary extra prize opportunity at our tournaments. Holes are designated as the shootout holes and those who hit the green in regulation can enter their names into drawings. At present, the shootout holes for home tournaments are 12 and 17. For away tournaments the Tournament Director selects one shootout hole. Players who want to enter place \$1 into the appropriate containers at the check-in table and sign the corresponding shootout sheet(s). There will be tickets and pencils in one container and a second container for signed tickets near the green of each shootout hole. Players who hit the green in regulation write their name on a ticket and place it in the second container. Upon completion of the tournament two names are drawn from the signed ticket container and those players split the pot.
