

UNIFORM GUIDLINES FOR BOH POSITIONS

ALL BOH

While some positions may vary, these are the general requirements.

- No keys should be on your belt or visible
- Phone should not be visible on your person (this includes in your back pocket)
- Black, closed-toe, non-slip kitchen shoes
- Clean white undershirt
- Chef coat and apron (provided)
- Black pants. No denim (belt loops and black belt required)
- Jewelry is reserved to wedding bands and watched for hands. Facial piercings
 must be removed for service. Any other jewelry should be kept minimal and may
 be subject to approval.
- Watches must have a rubber band, no metal or wood.

GROOMING

• All Grooming and Hygiene Requirements must be followed.

TO REITERATE

- Hair must be clean, groomed, and pulled back off the shoulders.
- Chef Beanie must be worn (provided)
- Facial hair can be no longer than 4mm, or you must wear a face hair net. Any facial hair should be clean and trimmed.
- Nails must be clean, trim and functional. No fake nails or chipping polish.
- No perfume or cologne should ever be worn.

SMOKING

The Hotel Burg is smoke free property. Employees may not smoke on premises. Also smoking is bad for you. Please stop. But if you must, All smoke or vape breaks must be off the clock, off property and must be taken totally out of sight of any guests of the restaurants and hotel. If an employee does smoke, they must wash their hands and eat some type of mint or otherwise ensure that any smoke smell will not affect our guests.
