

Historical or Literary Figure Project

Project overview

In this project, you will focus on a real historical figure or a character from a book. Your goal is to show who this person is, what they did, and why they matter. You will create a container or display that brings your figure to life through facts, objects, and creative details. Think of it like building a small exhibit about a person someone could explore.

Instructions / Directions

- Choose or be assigned a historical figure or literary character
- Research important details (background, actions, personality, impact, important events)
- Find a container (can, box, etc.) or small display to represent your figure
- Decorate the outside so it clearly connects to your person
- Create note cards with facts written in your own words
- Include artifacts that represent your figure (objects, symbols, or created items)
- Explain each artifact so it is clear why it connects to the figure
- Organize everything so it is neat and easy to understand

Criteria

Your work will be graded based on how well you show understanding of the figure, the accuracy of your information, the connections between your artifacts and your person, creativity, effort, and overall presentation.

Rubric

Level	Description
A	10+ strong facts/artifacts, clear and deep understanding, creative and detailed work, accurate information, excellent effort
B	At least 8 facts/artifacts, good understanding, mostly accurate, solid effort and creativity
C	Fewer than 8 items, basic understanding, some unclear or incomplete information
D/F	Incomplete or missing major parts, limited research, minimal effort

Additional notes

You can use real or created items. Think about what best represents your figure's life, choices, or personality. Try to include both important events and smaller details that help tell their story.
