

You Pick It!

Please choose NO LESS than 95 points worth of projects from the list. You may do as many points as you wish though you can only earn up to 110 points. You will need to use your book or any other resources you may find though the project MUST COVER material found in chapters 27 – 29.

Poster: Create a poster dictating any event from either chapter. Poster will be worth a total of 20 points and will be graded for historical accuracy and aesthetic presentation.

Brochure: Create a brochure for westward settlement into the new frontier. Be sure to include stories of American heroes like Daniel Boone and Lewis and Clark. Also, make sure to have accounts of farming conditions, weather and any Native Americans that might be in the area.

Brochure will be worth a total of 30 points and be graded on the following; historical accuracy (10 pts), presentation (10 pts), creativity (10 pts).

Poem/Song: You may create a poem or song about the times. Perhaps you will write a limerick calling for war with France or sing the praises of George Washington. It's up to you what you do!

Poem/Song will be worth 25 points and will be graded on the following; creativity (10 pts), historical relevance (10 pts), presentation (5 pts)

Journal: You may create a journal detailing your experiences back at the turn of the 19th century. You may write a journal pretending that you are experiencing events during the war of 1812 or maybe that you are on the Louisiana Purchase exploration. Perhaps your family has just moved to the frontier? What are you experiencing?

The journal must be in a journal format and include dates and a “dear diary/journal” heading. The journal must have at least 6 different entries and include 2 significant dates from the chapters.

Journal will be worth 40 points and be graded on the following; creativity (10 pts), historical relevance (10pts), presentation (10pts), length (10pts).

Any questions or alternatives to the project should be written and placed in my mail box. Changes will be considered. After all, this is YOU PICK IT!
