This picture of me is shortly after I came home from spending 319 days between the hospital and the nursing home. This is my favorite shirt. It has memorable movie quotes all over it.


I am currently working on a new novel that will be the first part of a trilogy. It is a love story about two friends and how they cross each other's paths

# The best insurance for protecting your intellectual property

I just got back the copyright registration for my upcoming book. It cost me sixty-five dollars and I completed the registration right online. It took me maybe ten minutes



total. This simple process is how I protect my books from thieves. I work very hard on my writing, and I don't want anyone to steal it from me. This provides me with proof of my ownership of my books.

If I could only give writers one piece of advice, it would be: get your copyright! You may be glad you did later.
