COURSE RULES

INDIAN HILLS GOLF COURSE IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR PLAY AND/OR MEMBERSHIP

NO SPIKES:

No spikes are allowed on Indian Hills Golf Course. This policy has been enforced to protect the greens.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:

IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR LIQUORS ON THE INDIAN HILLS GOLF COURSE PREMISES UNLESS IT IS PURCHASED FROM THE CADDY SHACK. SECTION 12-47-128, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES.

REGISTRATION BEFORE GOLF:

All golfers must register and sign in before golfing on Indian Hills Golf Course.

Registration is done in the Caddy Shack. If Caddy Shack is closed, register in outside box. Registration is beneficial for data on how many rounds of golf are played in a year and also lets us know who is on the course for player control for green fees, etc., and in case of emergencies.

STARTING PLAY:

All play should start on Hole #1, unless otherwise authorized by the Caddy Shack.

DIVOTS ON FAIRWAYS ---- BALL MARKS ON GREENS ---- SAND TRAPS:

Divots on fairways are to be replaced before going on to your next ball. This will allow the grass to grow back sooner in this spot and will help keep another golfer's ball from landing in a bare spot where a divot was not replaced.

Ball marks on greens should be repaired.

Sand traps must be raked after walking or hitting out of them.

WATER HAZARDS:

The lake on #7 and #9 shall be played as a LATERAL water hazard and the Tear Drop on #7 shall be played as a water hazard. (Refer to USGA Rule 26)

CART PATHS:

Stay on cart paths where provided when approaching a tee box or a green.

Stay 30' (feet) away from tee boxes or greens.

When leaving a cart path onto a fairway, scatter at end of cart path to avoid creating a dry, worn area at end of cart path. Avoid driving in the rough as much as possible.

OPEN GOLFING:
