HIGH SCHOOL GOLF MEMBERS AGREEMENT FORM

HPRAI welcomes and allows the Yuma High School girls' and boys' golf teams to use Indian Hills Golf Course, with all participants of the teams following policies, rules and regulations set forth by HPRAI.

Course rules require that YHS team members sign the register book in the Caddy Shack before playing the course <u>during</u> practice and before playing the course <u>after</u> practice.

If a team member is listed under their parents' membership or the team member has a Junior Membership, they can golf anytime there is open golf without paying green fees. If a team member is not listed under one of these memberships, they will pay Junior green fees of \$5.00, if they are golfing anytime other than directly after practice. Junior green fee allows all day play for \$5.00, providing open play is being allowed.

Other than the above stipulations, team members will be allowed to play for free only during or directly after practice.

Team members must follow all course rules and do not have priority over other golfers during practice or play after practice.

Team members may practice on the chipping and putting green and on the driving range, <u>but should not practice on the course</u> on Wednesdays or Thursdays, as these days are typically reserved for leagues. This would apply only during league season, which normally runs from mid-May to mid-August. Coaches shall check with Caddy Shack staff on dates of league season each year.

Team members <u>cannot have an organized practice on weekends or during tournaments</u>. If a team member does golf on a weekend or during a tournament, they are then considered a regular golfer and will follow all policies for regular golfers.

YHS team members will be allowed free range balls for use during practice or tournaments, but will be responsible for picking up these balls. Use of the range ball cart to pick these balls up must be preauthorized by the Caddy Shack staff or Course Superintendent.

It is a course violation to intentionally hit balls across County Road 39 on the north side of the driving range. Ball marks on greens and divots on fairways or tee boxes must be repaired by the person responsible for making them. Please fix any other ball marks or divots you may see, even if they are not yours! If charged with a course rule violation, privileges will be suspended.

**Practice and playing at Indian Hills is a privilege! To continue playing privileges, all team members must read and comply with the policy above, or they will not be able to continue to have team privileges.
