## HIGH SCHOOL GOLF TEAMS AGREEMENT FORM BETWEEN

## YUMA HIGH SCHOOL & HPRAI-INDIAN HILLS GOLF COURSE

FOR THE BOYS & GIRLS GOLF TEAMS

High Plains Recreation Association, Inc. welcomes and allows the Yuma High School girls' and boys' golf teams to use Indian Hills Golf Course. YHS and YHS Golf Team Coaches and Assistants agree to follow policies, rules and regulations set forth by HPRAI.

- YHS Golf Team Coach shall submit to the Caddy Shack Coordinator a <u>list of team golfers</u> before practice sessions start for a season.
- <u>The coach</u> (or substitute in case of coach absence) must be at the golf course at all times when members are involved in practices, tournaments and scrimmages.
- Course rules require that YHS team members sign the <u>register book</u> in the Caddy Shack before playing the course <u>during</u> practice and before playing the course after practice. All other course rules must be strictly followed by team members.
- With respect to <u>range balls</u>, HPRAI's general position is that any range balls to be used by the YHS golf team or a visiting team during practices, matches or tournaments must be picked up from the driving range by YHS team members.
- Use of range ball cart by golf team members must be preauthorized by the Caddy Shack staff or Course Superintendent.
- Up to six rental carts will be **complimentary for coaches** to use during tournaments and scrimmages (2 coaches per cart). If more carts are needed, YHS will be responsible for arrangements to rent or borrow from other cart owners.
- Team <u>tournaments and scrimmages</u> must be scheduled by using the Tournament Request Form. These forms are available at the Caddy Shack. These requests should be submitted three weeks prior to tournaments or two weeks prior to scrimmages.
- One varsity match will be allowed during the girls' golf season and another during the boys' golf season.
- Two scrimmages and/or JV matches will be allowed during the girls' season and the same for the boys' golf season.
- <u>Tournament Fees</u> are \$75 per visiting team of four golfers, with no charge to YHS golf teams. There is also no charge to any team for scrimmages, providing the course isn't closed to public play during the scrimmage. If a JV tournament closes the course to public play, it will be treated the same as a varsity tournament. Checks should be made out to YHS. As soon as possible, YHS should write a check to HPRAI for 30% of the \$75 fees charged to visiting teams, the remaining 70% going to the golf program for the purpose of aiding that program for its expenses outside those normally funded by the school.
- If a YHS Team Member is listed under their **parents' membership** or has a Junior Membership, they can golf anytime there is open golf without paying green fees.
- If a Team Member is **not listed under one of these memberships**, they will pay Junior green fees of \$5.00, if they are golfing anytime other than <u>directly</u> after practice. Junior green fee allows all day play for \$5.00.
- Team members cannot have an organized <u>practice on weekends or during tournaments</u>. If a team member does golf on a weekend or during a tournament, they are then considered a regular golfer and must follow such policy for regular golfers.
- Any other course usage situation that would close the course to public play will require prior approval by the Board.
- The chain of command for Indian Hills is the Course Superintendent and then the Board.
- The chain of command for YHS would be the Coach, the Athletic Director and then the Principal.

I have read, understand and agree to abide by all policies written above. I agree to indemnify and hold HPRAI, its agents and employees harmless from damage, claims, actions, liability and expenses from or in connection with the Yuma School District Personnel or Golf Teams.
