

## **MEMBERSHIP AND DUES POLICY**

**SINGLE:** One person.

**COUPLE:** Married or Common-law living at same address.

**FAMILY:** Husband and wife, sons or daughters of one or both spouses. If any son or daughter is 8 yrs. old by May 1 and playing golf, the membership is for a family, not a couple. If son/daughter living at home is over 18 and not a college age 18-22 (see college definition), full-time 12 cr. hr. student, he or she is not eligible under this family membership and must apply for a single membership. This family membership does not allow playing privileges for grandchildren.

**COLLEGE:** 18-22 yrs. of age, must still be 22 on May 1 and a full-time 12 cr. hr. student to have a College Membership.

**JUNIOR:** Must still be 17 on May 1 to be considered a Junior; if 18 before May 1, they cannot be a Junior.

See current year Membership Fee Schedule for rates. A membership and cart space rental is effective from January 1 – December 31. Payment for both is due by January 31. If payment for membership is not received by January 31, green fees must be paid to golf until such membership is paid in full.

Neither membership nor cart space rental fees can be prorated. New, first-time members, including those who were previously a member under their parent's membership, may, once in a lifetime, join at any time of the year and pay the January membership rate.

Previously paid green fees cannot be applied towards a membership. Membership dues must be paid prior to the first day of league play in order to participate in a league.

### **HARDSHIP CASES:**

A finance plan for hardship cases is available pursuant to HPRAI Bylaws, Article II, Section 3. A hardship application may be obtained from the HPRAI Treasurer. By signing the hardship application, the member(s) agrees to make all scheduled payments. If the applicant is a minor, a parent or guardian must sign the application and assume responsibility for the membership, if approved. Hardship memberships will be payable at the set price of dues for the month in which the application is received, as set forth in the current year Membership Fee Schedule. Three payment plans are available:

- 1) Four (4) equal installments due February 1, March 1, April 1 and May 1;
- 2) Three (3) equal installments due March 1, April 1 and May 1; or
- 3) Two (2) equal installments due April 1 and May 1.

Only the HPRAI Board of Directors can consider and approve hardship case applications.

### **DELINQUENT DUES:**

Any member with delinquent dues from the previous year must pay all such delinquent dues and all current year dues in advance in order to renew their membership.

Any member who joined HPRAI using a hardship case application and defaults on their payments will forfeit any previous payments and will lose all membership privileges, including, but not limited to, league play, club tournaments and voting rights, until their account is paid in full.
