General Instructions

- 1. The application and supporting material must be typed or clearly written in manuscript.
- 2. All supporting or extra documents must be submitted on 8 ½"x11" papers.
- 3. The applicant's name must be written on each page of the supporting documents.
- 4. Wherever the space provided in this form is not sufficient for an applicant to present fully the facts, an additional page may be attached.
- 5. Attach an official, sealed transcript of the applicants' <u>most recent</u> high school grades and credits to this application. Send the transcript to the address below if the institution does not permit the applicant to handle the transcript.
- 6. Include a 2-page grammatically correct, double-spaced, typed essay entitled, "What This Scholarship Means to Me."
- 7. Return this application and all attachments to the <u>individual or Subordinate Court</u> from which you received the application by <u>March 17, 2025</u>.
- 8. The Jurisdiction Grand Court **ONLY** will submit the application and supporting information to the General Conference Scholarship Chairperson no later than **April 1**, **2025**.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The Caldwell-Williams Scholarship stipends shall be awarded only to the Grand Courts that are members of the General Conference of Grand Courts, LOCOP, PHA, USA and The Bahamas and are participants in the Scholarship Fund-raising Project.
- 2. The Scholarship stipend will be awarded for the fall semester of the academic year to up to four (4) qualifying applicants from member Jurisdictions of the General Conference.
- 3. The stipends will be awarded after the winning applicant provides the Scholarship Committee with **evidence of actual enrollment** in a post-secondary educational institution.
- 4. A single Grand Court of the General Conference shall submit only one (1) application.
- 5. The individual applicant may not submit their application to the General Conference.
- 6. The Caldwell-Williams Scholarship recipient must be a graduating high school senior with a GPA (grade point average) of 2.5 or better, who has been accepted to an accredited post-secondary educational institution (college, business school, technological school, etc.).
- 7. The applicant must have been accepted to an accredited 2 or 4-year College or university.
- 8. The applicant must be of good character. Three (3) letters of recommendation, including two (2) from instructors/teachers and one (1) from an organizational leader, employer, or religious leader, must accompany the scholarship application packet.
- 9. This Scholarship is not available to students who have received a 4-year scholarship from any other organization or body.
- 10. The Scholarship stipend will be made payable to the selected applicant for fees, books, tuition, and other needs, rather than to the institution.
- 11. The <u>complete</u> scholarship application packet (with appropriate signatures and seal of the submitting subordinate court) must be mailed by the Jurisdictional Grand Secretary to the General Conference Scholarship Chairperson at the address below by the deadline noted on the Scholarship Application.
- 12. Illegible or incomplete applications will not be considered.
