



GENERAL CONFERENCE LOCOP CREDENTIALING GUIDELINES



1. The Registration Fee, State Jurisdictional Fees and individual Membership Fee must be paid before anyone can be seated and permitted to vote.
2. Excerpt from the Ratified 2023 General Conference Constitution and By-laws

Section 3 - Each Jurisdiction is entitled to five (5) votes as represented by:

1. Royal Grand Perfect Matron
2. Royal Grand Deputy Matron
3. Royal Grand Principal Conductress
4. Royal Grand Associate Conductress
5. Royal Grand Conductress of Ceremonies

And any Actual Past or Honorary Royal Grand Perfect Matrons

Section 4 – A Proxy is permissible by resolution in the absence of all official representatives of a Jurisdiction. A Past Royal Grand Perfect Matron can cast all five (5) Jurisdictional votes, and her vote for a total of six (6) votes. **A certified resolution from the Jurisdiction must bear the signatures of the Royal Grand Perfect Matron or the presiding officer at that time and the Royal Grand Secretary with the seal of the Jurisdiction affixed.**

ALL MUST BE REGISTERED TO VOTE.

Section 5 - All other members of the General Conference of Grand Courts, Ladies of the Circle of Perfection who are registered, are entitled to one vote on matters **OTHER** than the election of officers. The required Jurisdictional fee as stated in the current proclamation must have been paid to obtain such a privilege. **NO ADVISORS, RGCA or GC PRGCA's are permitted to Vote.**

3. No Credentials will be accepted after 12:00 noon of the Saturday's session.
