

Confirmation and First Communion Dress From Diocesan Guidelines

Diocesan Guidelines (#40) **Attire:** Candidates should dress modestly and in a manner consistent with the dignity and decorum of the sacred liturgy. Men should wear slacks, shirt, tie and dress shoes. Women should wear dresses with a modest neckline and which cover knees and shoulders. Gowns may be used. Stoles are not to be worn.

STM First Communion and Confirmation Dress Guidelines

All: Candidates should dress modestly and in a manner consistent with the dignity and decorum of the sacred liturgy.

Men/Boys: Men should wear slacks, shirt, tie and dress shoes.
(Jackets/suits are optional)

Women/Girls: Women should wear dresses with a modest neckline and which cover knees and shoulders. Gowns may be used. Veils/Mantillas are optional. Stoles are not to be worn. Gloves are not to be worn.

Note: *If spaghetti strap or sleeveless dresses are worn, then a short jacket or sweater must be worn at all times on the Church property.* Necklines must be modest. Skirt length must cover the knees.
