

Studio 68 Dress Code

At Studio 68, we follow a dress code for weekly classes. We believe this encourages unity, discipline, focus, and respect among our students. Street clothes are not allowed in class. It is important that dancers present a neat and elegant appearance to minimize distractions in the classroom. Hair must be pulled away from the face, up off the neckline, and secured to the head. Ballet buns are preferred, and we are happy to show you how!

Lyrical	Tan stirrup tights (performance) or convertible/adaptatooe tights (class)	Any color/style leotard	<u>Traditional:</u> Capezio Foot Undeez in Nude (#H07) <u>Lyrical Companies:</u> Dance Paws in Nude <small>*Company shoe requirements for performance may change based on costumes.</small>
Acro	Any color footless, convertible or stirrup tights, leggings or shorts (must be barefoot). Ponytail is acceptable.	Any color/style leotard.	No shoes needed. Neat ponytails are acceptable for this class. T-shirts are not permitted.

The only exception to this dress code is the last class of the month - Color Week. During this week, students may wear any color/style dancewear/accessories to all classes. Shoe and hair requirements remain the same.
