COWRA 2026 INFORMATION SHEET

Admin/Paperwork

A copy of your license and current medical will need to be sighted after arrival.
A signed copy of the "Informed Consent" document is required after arrival. It can viewed and printed using the following link:<https://redradials.com.au/>.

Parking

The planned parking areas are indicated on the attached airfield diagram.

Airfield Operations

A one way taxiing system will be used for our operations around the parking areas.
This will be dependant on the runway in use: Clockwise for 33 and counter-clockwise for 15. **After landing take the second taxiway to vacate the runway.**
When taxiing for departure use the runway entrance closest to the landing threshold.
Right hand circuits are now required when using RWY 15.

Flying

A ramped flying program is planned to progress to 4-ship close/TAC form.
This will be tailored to individual experience levels. Those arriving later in the week will be accommodated, as best as possible.

SOPs

The start of good formation flights is Standard Operating Procedures and good briefings.
At Red Lightning we will be using the Red Radials SOPs and the Formation Procedures & Techniques Manual.

Operations Area

Briefings and operations will be conducted in the Fly Oz hangar.

Transport

A bus will be available for transport to and from town in the morning and afternoon.

Accommodation

The Townhouse and Aalana Motels are recommended, but there are a number of options available around the town.

Fuel

Fuel will be available from the Flyoz tanker "in the lines".

You will need to register by visiting Fly Oz on arrival.

The owner/person responsible, will be required to be with the aircraft whilst it is being refuelled, unless prior arrangements with the Fly Oz refueller have been made.

- All fuel provided will also require a docket to be signed at completion of the refuel by the owner/person responsible for the aircraft, unless prior arrangements with Fly Oz have been made.

All accounts to be settled prior to departure.

A self service bowser (Visa, MC) is also available near the aircraft parking area.

Oil

Tim Reid at Fred Fahey Aerial Services will be supplying oil.
The following types and sizes will be available:

Aeroshell W120, 5 litre
Phillips X/C 25W-60, quart.

You can run an account for each aircraft, to be settled before departure. He would prefer cash, but other payment options may be available. These may not include credit card.

Breakfast & Lunch

Cowra Inner Wheel will be catering lunch at the airfield.

Breakfast will need to be procured individually from a cafe in town, although a continental type selection may be available at the airfield.

Please advise any dietary requirements.

Lunch on the Friday may be a BBQ with Flyoz (\$10/head)

Air

Air will be available.

Laundry

For those travelling light, a laundry service is available at the laundrette across the road from the Aalana Motel and there is a clothes washing machine at the Townhouse Motel.

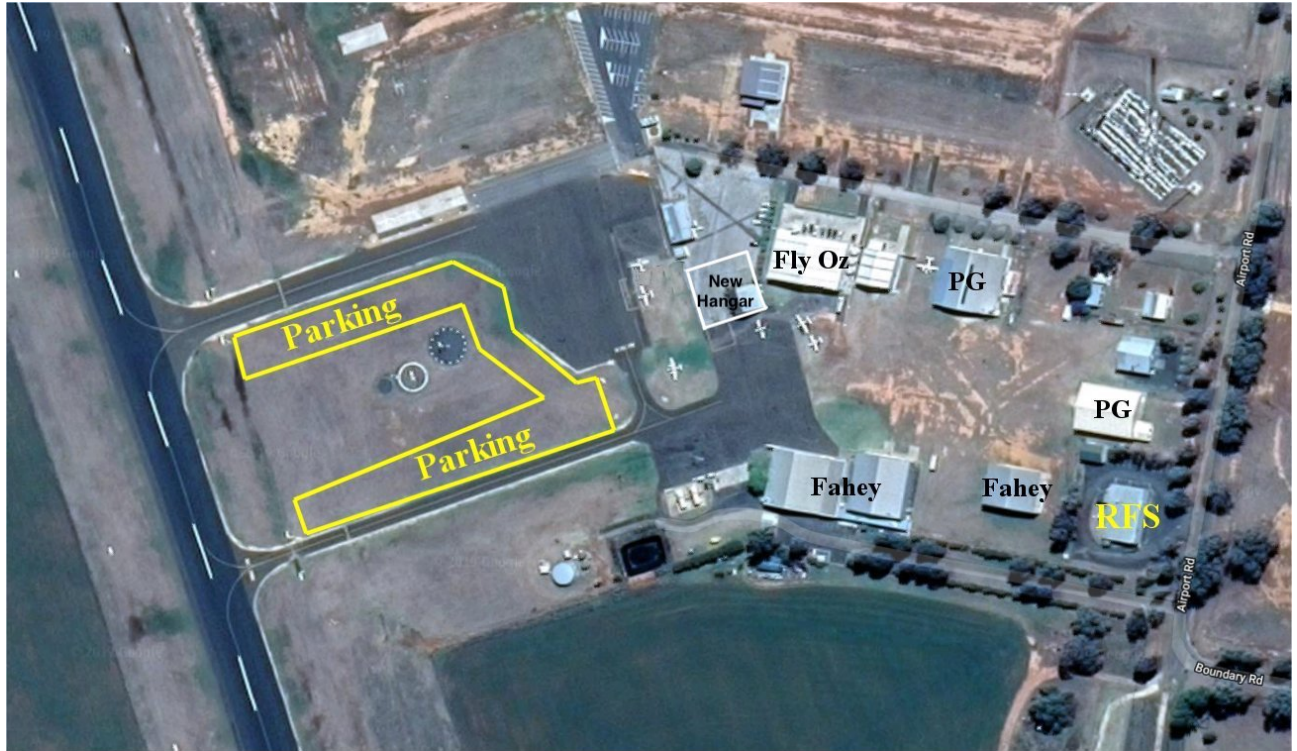
