## 4. Admission Process

### 4.1 Overview

### 4.2 Eligibility Criteria

#### Undergraduate Programs

- Completion of 10+2 or equivalent from a recognized board.
- Minimum qualifying marks as prescribed by individual departments.
- For B.Th: Candidates must demonstrate a background in Christian studies and may need to pass an entrance assessment.

#### Postgraduate Programs

- Bachelor's degree in the relevant field from a recognized university.
- Minimum aggregate score of 50% or equivalent GPA.
- Entrance tests or personal interviews may be required for selected programs.

#### PhD Programs

- A postgraduate degree in the relevant discipline with at least 55% aggregate marks.
- Research proposal and written entrance test.
- Interview with the Research Committee.

### 4.3 Application Procedure

The application process at NECU is streamlined and accessible both online and offline.

1. **Online Application:** Applicants can visit [www.necu.ac.in](http://www.necu.ac.in) to fill out the application form, upload documents, and pay the application fee.
2. **Offline Application:** Printed application forms can be collected from the Admissions Office or downloaded and submitted with necessary documents via post.
3. **Required Documents:**
  - Academic transcripts
  - Transfer and conduct certificates
  - Identity proof
  - Passport-sized photographs
  - Statement of purpose (for PG and PhD applicants)

These experiences strengthen student understanding of social issues and develop empathy and problem-solving skills.


### **9.4 Centre for Peace and Development**
