If this isn't the place to be, I'm not sure where is.

We'd like to sincerely thank the Boards of **PITA** and **WSPITA** for continuing to place their trust in Evergreen to help host their most prestigious shoots. For decades, Evergreen has been home to these major events, and we're confident that 2026 will be another outstanding year.

If it's been a while since you've been out, you'll notice some exciting improvements. You'll be welcomed by an updated Evergreen sign (thank you, Rochester High School), along with new interior flooring, paint, and lighting. Many campers travel with pets or essential medical equipment, and overloading the system due to improper use could create serious safety issues. Please be courteous, be kind, and work together to keep everyone safe.

Camping reservations can be made on our website and golf carts reserved by sending me an email (limited qty and prices between \$450-750). Spaces are filling up, so don't delay.

Vendor spaces are free, as always. If you're interested in vending, send me an email with what you plan to sell and the space you'll need. Please note: Vendor spaces do not include utilities. To assist with planning, vendor registration must be completed by July 1.

Whether you're joining us for the State Shoot, the Grand Pacific, or both... Our staff, volunteers, and board are excited to welcome you to what promises to be an incredible July at Evergreen.

Every shooter that shoots the entire program (Event 3, 28 gauge is Excluded). This will function exactly how a standard Lewis option functions, just using the shooter's HOA Scores.

This will take place on Thursday the 9th, following the Liberty Mutual Handicap. There is no cost associated with this event. We will draw **TWO** numbers out of a hat 0-9. This drawing will take place after the day's handicap is concluded. Based on the numbers drawn, any shooter who shot a score in that days handicap that ended with one of the numbers drawn is eligible for the shoot off. **An example** being if a number 2 and 8 were drawn, any shooter who broke a 52, 58, 62, 68, 72, 78, 82, 88, 92, 98, etc. would qualify for the shoot off. This shoot off will take place at the end of the day. Every shooter that qualifies will report to the announcer if they wish to participate. The shoot off itself will be 23 yard line, single shot, continental, in a miss and you are out style shoot off. **1st place is 20oz Silver bar and 2nd place is a 10oz bar, no splitting, shooters must shoot it out to completion**
**PITA rules apply to shooter's shells and loads.

\$10 off per event for JR and Sub-JR Shooters!

This is applied to all events. However, if the JR/Sub-JR shooter plays ANY options for any specific event, that specific event will not be discounted.

2026 WSPITA Options and Free Entries!!!!

Free Team Silver Shootout Sponsored by WSPITA

This will take place on Friday the 10th, for the Jerry Angiuli handicap. Those shooters that have experience with the Big Yak Blanket shoot will be familiar with how it works. Teams of 5 shooters will be made by luck of the draw. The team of 5 shooters with the highest combined scores for Event 7 will win a total of **25oz of silver! That is one, 5oz silver bar, per team member!**

\$10 Option Browning CXT miss and you're out shoot off sponsored by Angiuli Family and WSPITA!

This will take place on Friday the 10th, following the Jerry Angiuli Handicap and is a **\$10 option**. We will draw a number out of a hat 0-9. This drawing will take place after the day's handicap is concluded. Based on the number drawn, an example being a number 8 being drawn, any shooter who broke a 58, 68, 78, 88, 98, etc. would qualify for the shoot off. This shoot off will take place at the end of the day, and will be conducted at each shooters yardage. Miss and you're out, last shooter standing wins the gun! **PITA rules apply to shooter's shells and loads.

\$10 off per event for JR and Sub-JR Shooters!

This is applied to all events. **However, if the JR/Sub-JR shooter plays ANY options for any specific event, that specific event will not be discounted.**

WSPITA reserves the right to change any terms and conditions in these rules. **ALL WSPITA DECISIONS ARE FINAL**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Advance Squadding available through: [SoSClays](#) (page 19). Pre-squadding will open on **March 10th, 2026** and close on **July 5th, 2026**.

Entry fees will be in U.S. currency, American check or Canadian check in U.S. funds (NSF fee \$35.00). A \$5 pre-squadding fee will be paid at registration at the shoot. Shooters requesting squad changes after the shoot begins will pay a \$10.00 change fee.

Refunds – No entry fees, purses or options, will be refunded after an event has started.

Payoffs – **All** payoffs will be paid by check and mailed to shooters after this shoot ends. Check event payoff sheets prior to the start of the last event for any questions.

IRS REGULATIONS – Before checks over \$599.00 can be distributed, the IRS requires form W-9 to be completed. Please furnish this information to the cashier or the WSPITA Treasurer.

Three Minute Call – Be ready to shoot when your squad is called. **The squad will be held no more than 3 minutes, after which time you will need to re-squad.**

Re-squadding will be on the same bank as the original, if possible. Ten (10) minutes will be allowed for gun breakdown.

No shooter will be called on the loud speaker. **STRICTLY ENFORCED!**

Short Squads – Short squads will be avoided when possible. A referee will accompany one and two person squads.

Target Setting – Targets will be set by the **Target Setting Team** each day according to PITA rules.

Targets will be reset ONLY if the setting changes present a significant variation. All resetting of targets must be done by authorized personnel.

Ties – All ties in preliminary events will be carried over, if possible, otherwise a shoot off will take place. All Championship events will be decided by a shoot off.

Shoot Offs – **One call ONLY.** Contestant must be available at the shoot off table within five minutes after being called for shoot off or will forfeit all rights herein. Look for posting on bulletin board. Any **SUB-JUNIOR (SJ), JUNIOR (JR), LADY (LD), VETERAN (VT), SENIOR (SR), ELDER (EL)** shooter must declare for which trophy they wish to compete for prior to entering into a shoot-off. One trophy ONLY may be won.

Special Categories – Prior to shooting each event, if you qualify in any special category, i.e. Sub-Junior (under 15), Junior (15-17), Lady, Veteran (65-69), Senior (70-74), or Elder (75 and older) please check your handicap sheet and score sheets to make certain your name shows the proper symbol for eligibility. Failure to do so within 10 min after the last score is posted will disqualify you from options AND trophies. Must be two or more shooters in a category for a trophy to be awarded.

Handicapping – PITA rules govern. It's the shooter's responsibility to show both PITA & ATA average cards to determine handicap yardage assignments. Your PITA card must be complete with all scores entered through the last shoot you attended, with averages computed on the last **1000** Singles and Doubles. Personnel at the handicap table will assist you if necessary. A shooter who is an ATA member, and is joining the PITA for the first time will be assigned yardage equal to their ATA yardage. If a shooter has assigned yardage in both the ATA and the PITA, the greater yardage will be assigned. At State/Provincial and Grand Pacific Championship tournaments, all shooters who have **NOT** shot at the listed quantity of PITA registered Singles and Handicap targets during the current and previous year combined, shall be assigned penalty class and/or yardage per PITA rule book.

Minimum of 300 targets -or- assigned **Class B** (SJ, JR, SV, EL)

Minimum of 500 targets -or- assigned **Class B** (VT, LD, All Others)

Doubles:

Minimum of 100 targets -or- assigned **Class B** (SJ, JR, SV, EL)

Minimum of 200 targets -or- assigned **Class B** (VT, LD, All Others)

Membership – All participants in the program must be a current member of the PITA.

Guns and Loads - All contestants shall follow the PITA established rules regarding guns and loads found on pages 15-17 of the PITA RULE BOOK.

Earned Yardage – If you earn yardage during the shoot, you must check with the office. It may be necessary to re-squad you.

Class Winners will be advanced to next class on all future events.

Please read your program and current Rules Book.

KNOW THE RULES...do not put all the responsibility on the referee when you are shooting!

Chair Classification – An eligible shooter in the Chair Classification shall be a shooter who is physically disabled and due to such physical disability is required to be seated in a cart or wheelchair while shooting.

Shooter Responsibility – A shooter must shoot in the proper class and at the correct yardage. An error at the handicap table does not excuse any shooter from this responsibility of knowing the rules.

Disqualification and Suspension - Per page 23 of the PITA RULE BOOK; ‘Officials of the State/Provincial Associations are authorized to disqualify and recommend for suspension, any contestant violating current PITA rules or whose conduct, in their judgment, is unsafe, unsportsmanlike, or disruptive to the harmony of any registered tournament...’

All shooters shall keep their squads moving at a continuous pace. There shall be NO ‘playing through’. Shoot management **only** shall determine any special issue delays in shooting.

Errors in Scores – Scores must be contested and settled before the shooter starts shooting on the next post, otherwise the score must stand.

Pets “must” be kept on a leash. Please don’t allow them to forage on deceased critters, and remember to pick up after them... no land mines!

This is to certify that the Evergreen Sportsmen’s Club has been authorized to hold a registered shoot at Littlerock, WA on July 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th, and 12th, 2026. The Pacific International Trapshooting Association rules will govern all events and scores will be included in the official record.

## **FRIENDLY REMINDER**

### **Regarding Added Money**

If you earn Class or Yardage added money, you are not eligible for Special Category added money. Just like a trophy, if you win Runner Up, you are not eligible for Veteran, Etc.

**Cross-Registration** – Targets may be cross-registered with the ATA, subject to all the fees, rules, and requirements. The shooter must be a current member of the ATA and pay appropriate ATA daily fees and target fees. Earned yardage will be awarded according to the rules of the PITA and will apply directly to all cross-registered targets. Cards of **BOTH** associations will be punched from the yardage shot.

**Orange White Flyer Western 3/4 New York Style Targets** will be utilized for all registered events and shoot offs.

**Rules** - By entering the competition, every shooter agrees to accept all official decisions and abide by the PITA rules. Members are strongly encouraged to know the rules and abide by them, both for their own benefit and for the benefit of the other shooters.

**Registration** – All targets in the program will be registered with the PITA.

**Rookie Of The Year** – Any Washington state shooter who has not registered any targets in any association until after the **2025** WSPITA State Shoot is eligible to compete for this award. The winning state Rookie will represent Washington State at the **2026** PITA Grand Pacific. Awarded on the Singles (Events 6 & 8) and Handicap (Event 9) State Championship events. (A Sub-Junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. A Junior is person who has not attained their 18th birthday.)

**Champion of Champions** - Open to the Champion and Lady Champion of the **2026** WA Singles Championship events. Should the winner not be in attendance at the **2026** Pacific Grand, the next highest scoring contestant may compete for Champion of Champions. This event is run by the Exec. Committee of the PITA at the Pacific Grand.

**Champion of Champions & Rookie Competitions at the Grand Pacific** – Should the State/Provincial Champion or Runner up be absent from the Grand the person with the next highest score, in attendance, may represent that State/Province in the competition.

**Entries must be posted on the sheet provided on the bulletin board/table prior to 9:00 am Saturday, July 11th, 2026.**

**Two in a family (Sportco):** Based on the combined scores of the two related family members for event 11 Championship Handicap. The two related family members must register to participate at the handicap table before the start of event #11.

**Buddy Backer Winners (Heritage Bank):** Winners of the state shoot buddy backer will each be awarded a special trophy thanks to Heritage Bank!

**HAA Chair (Klinge Family):** Top HAA (Event 6-9) Chair will be awarded a special buckle thanks to Klinge Family!

**Husband and Wife (Paul Davis Restoration):** Top Husband and Wife team for Events 8 & 9, based on the total 400 targets for both shooters.

## **CLUB TEAM COMPETITION**

All Washington State club team members must be posted on the sheet provided on the bulletin board prior to 9:00 a.m., **Saturday, July 11th, 2026**. One Washington State “at-large” team will be allowed. Club team members must be current members of their respective PITA clubs, prior to the **2026 State Shoot**. The club must have thrown PITA targets. The “At-Large” team is set aside for PITA members who shoot PITA targets but live in areas where there are no clubs throwing PITA targets, such as South Eastern Washington and North Eastern Washington. If two or more shooters sign up for the “at large” team in any class the WSPITA Board of Directors will draw lots to resolve the final “at large” team.

Each four shooter team will be comprised of one shooter from each class AA, A, B, C, or D. A shooter in a lower class may substitute for a higher class shooter. Example: a “B” shooter can fill the “A” or “AA” billet. Washington State clubs may enter as many teams as they can man. A shooter may only be on one team.

## SPECIAL OPTIONS 2026

### Washington State Singles Magnum Option

**Purse Cost: \$12 Current Total Purse: \$435.14 plus day's entries**

Shooters are eligible for 25% of the purse per event. It will be split between all shooters who qualify. To qualify, a shooter must break a qualifying score within their class. These scores are as follows:

AA: 100      A: 100      B: 99      C: 98      D: 97

**EXAMPLE:** Bob in AA Class breaks a 100 and Jim in D Class breaks a 98. Both shooters broke a qualifying score and are entitled to a quarter of the pot plus 1/2 of the daily entries split between them.

### Washington State Shoot Handicap Magnum Options

**Purse Cost: \$14 Current Total Purse: \$3,011.65 plus day's entries**

Functions like normal magnum option except that it applies for only the Washington State shoot. Purse for each trap is as follows (50% payout, all ties divide. Purse may vary by shoot date.)

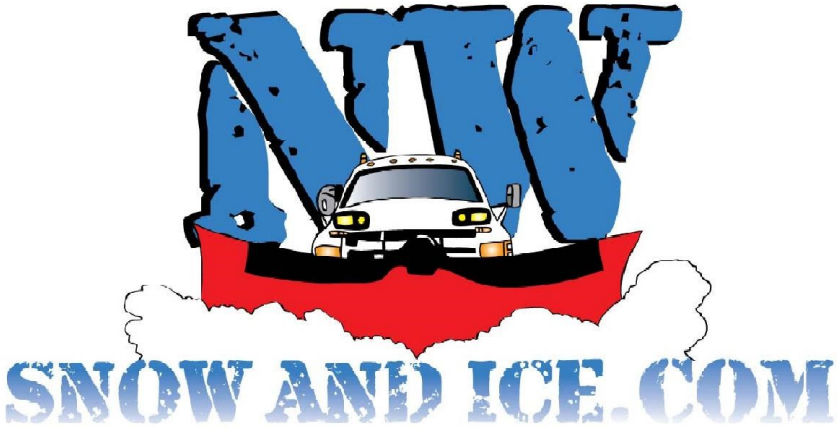

His resume began many years ago, as early as 1947 when he joined the Port Angeles Gun club. He served as Washington state handicap chairman for 14 years. In addition to the service years, he has also shot over 200,00 targets. In 1980 at the Grand Pacific in Stockton California he was HOA runner up to another 2018 inductee, Dan Bonillas.

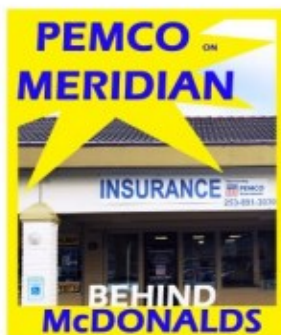

The contestant **MUST** shoot both 200 Championship Singles targets and 100 Handicap targets. The winner of the Rookie of the Year will have the highest average of the contestants that apply. Annual State winners are then qualified to compete at the Grand Pacific for “Rookie of the Year.” If the State winner fails to attend the Grand Pacific, the runner up may attend and compete in their place.

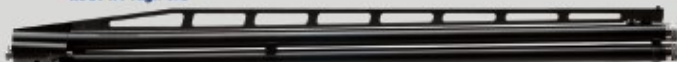

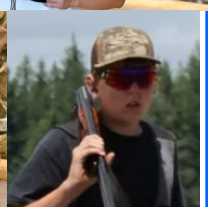
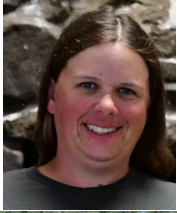
