

Last year Post 243 elected to take ownership of the Florida's Fallen Memorial and committed to displaying it in our community for the weeks before and after Memorial Day. Since then, we wrapped the trailer for better visibility and advertising purposes (thanks to several generous donations), converted our Jewish members of the Memorial to Stars of David, added two new names (due to accidents), included KIA signage for those that perished at the hands of the enemy, updated hundreds of awards and decorations, completely remade our 13 campaign crosses, updated our Gold Star banner, lost two canopy tents in the storm on the night of May 21st, and spent 156 hours faithfully sitting with the Memorial. This could not have been done without ALL OFYOU!
