It is mandatory that a blaze orange vest or jacket be worn as an outer garment.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are ineligible to enter and entry fees will be refunded for a bitch withdrawn for coming into season.

CONDUCT ON THE GROUNDS

During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no training on the grounds. During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of live ammunition, except by the Official Gunners during the test. During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of blank pistols, except by the handlers during their brace running time.

HUNT TEST DIRECTIONS

East or West bound on Interstate 40 take Exit 178 (Parks Exit).

* From the exit go north about 1/2 mile.

* Turn left (west) at “T” intersection.

*Turn right (north) on Spring Valley Road (County Road 141)

There’s a convenience store on the right.

*Go north for approximately 7 3/4 miles.

*Turn right (east) on Forest Service Road 194.

*Follow FS Road 194 to FS 786—bear toward the right

*Continue on FS 786 to Red Tank

* Signs will be posted at Spring Valley Rd./FS 194 and at FR 194/FS 786

GUNS AND AMMUNITION

Handlers in all levels need a blank pistol, incapable of shooting live ammo. Handlers in the Master Level need to carry an empty breakopen shotgun. The Official Guns may carry only double barrel break apart shotguns of at least 20 gauge. Semi automatic and pump guns are prohibited.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Electronic devices, including beeper or locator collars, and dummy devices, as well as prong, pincher, or shock type collars, shall not be worn by a dog while it is running in a Hunting Test. Tracking collars will be permitted for use under AKC rules and regulations.

HUMANE TREATMENT OF GAME

AKC rules and regulations clearly prohibit any hobbling or shackling of game. **NO ONE** has the authority to order game crippled or maimed. Anyone guilty of violating AKC rules and regulations will be severely disciplined.
