Please briefly present the partner organisation

Kütahya Specialized Tennis Club was founded in 2016. Offering its service on Abdurrahman Karaa Boulevard and in GHSİM sports complex (provincial directorate of youth and sports services), our club has two outdoor and one indoor tennis courts. Integrated into Turkey Tennis Federation, our club's board of management consists of tennis lovers. Our operations initially were maintained with The Ministry of Youth and Sports. However, After Tennis Federation became an autonomous organisation, it has been completely connected to Tennis Federation. Among our board members of management, there are academicians, trainers, volunteers, sportsmen and women. Our Tennis Club aims to give information and trainings to the people interested from all ages. Some of our clubs activities can be listed as;

- An ability scan activity at 6 different schools in Kütahya was performed.
- Worldwide activity PLAY AND STAY IN TENNIS was performed in Kütahya at the same time with 37 countries.
- With the help of formed commission, the matches between schools and toddlers were supported with Tennis Agency of the City.
- The interest of tennis among youngsters have been raised.
- The number of licensed tennis players have been increased and the numbers of quitting sports aka Burnout has been decreased.
- Publicity and interest of this sport has been achieved throughout the city with the tournaments happening every year.
- Thanks to our clubs efforts, we have tennis players who have degrees in Turkey.

Our main vision is not only to make individuals become healthy with sports, but also make them licensed tennis players staying away from the street and harmful habits with the help of tennis.

What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

Our tennis specialization club with 2 managers, 4 trainers and 1 physiotherapist within and with numerous players is a very active organization with all its organs. Our club brought something new by implementing the project "Play and stay in the game" with 37 world countries. In Kütahya Tennis Club, tournaments are being held every year for kids, juniors, youngsters and veterans. Also with our "Street Tennis" activities, we aim to introduce tennis sport and raise interest in bigger areas. Our coached players have achieved successes in special tournaments among schools by getting degrees in Turkey. Moreover, with the help of tennis sports, up to 40 poor kids whose ages range from 10 to 16 have been our licensed players of our club. Therefore they changed their lifestyles and got rid of bad habits.

Our tennis club's planned projects with social content aim to meet the teens in our club with socially disabled teens or teens with bad habits, and thus, they could rehabilitate through tennis. They will also stay in school and will have their self-improvement with the help of EU projects.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?

Our club president and legal representative Cüneyt KÖŞE is a second level tennis coach and a chief referee as a veteran player with a tennis career of 20 years and with experience in EU projects for more than 10 years. He also maintains his position as Kütahya Tennis Provincial Representative. He attended trainings in EU projects as youth leader during the years when The Turkish National Agency was founded. He shared all the accumulation from his trainings with the local entrepreneurs and he took charge in the implementation of the projects both in his country and in foreign countries.

The contact person of the project S.Cagri KOSE is also a licensed sportsman within tennis backgrounds. With the authority from Tennis Specialization Club, his duty is to raise interest in Tennis sports among more people and introduce tennis to the underprivileged young people. He has huge experience in EU projects as he attended in many types of projects.

Our staffed trainer in our tennis club, Can SÖNMEZ attended an EVS project in Italy-Palermo and he has another active role in the project. Also our tennis club members who have attended an EU project previously and can

speak a foreign language will contribute to the project's activities.

How are you going to make this project visible and to disseminate and exploit its results?

Each of our international projects are heavily promoted on our website in both Turkish and English We will also e-mail all of our 2000 youths in our mailing list with the information about your project once it is approved in order to make sure that we attract the most suitable participants to attend your project.

After the participants come back from your project we will again post a "project report" and photographs from your project Furthermore, we will organise a monthly gatherings where participants from international projects talk about their experiences, show pictures, run activities and make sure that the knowledge that they learnt during the international seminar they will attend gets pass on to others. We will also organise mini-seminars in secondary schools and universities where the participants from your project would disseminate their knowledge by running workshops.
