- Cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children.
- Today over 43 children will be diagnosed with a form of childhood cancer and 7+ children will die of cancer.
- Of every 5 children diagnosed with cancer 1 child will die - 4 children will have life long negative side effects from their toxic treatment.

Since the inaugural iDance4aCURE events on November 16, 2013. iDance4aCURE has funded cutting edge research at Children's National Health Systems (DC), Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, Children's Hospital of Los Angeles, UCLA and Hackensack UMC.
