ELIGIBILITY:

This is an open match. All competitors must be current members of USA Shooting in order to participate. The match will be open to international guests as well. International athletes must be a member of their home federation. All international athletes should submit a copy of the picture page of their passport with their entry form. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible to win National Championship. International guests must complete the entry form on the last page of this program. International athletes will not be eligible for awards as this is a U.S. National Championship only.

Note: Standard Rifle is now an ISSF Open Event (meaning it is open to both Men & Women). The three competitors with the highest aggregate Standard Rifle scores will be considered for team selection regardless of gender.

RULES:

Per USA Shooting the match will follow 2017 ISSF Rulebook and amendments (or as changed by USA Shooting). It is the shooters responsibility to be familiar with these rules. Match Directors bulletins will also rule this match, See "Special Conditions" below.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented Thursday Evening and Saturday Afternoon.

Women's 3-P: gold, silver, bronze
Men's Prone: gold, silver, bronze
Women's Prone: gold, silver, bronze
Standard Rifle: gold, silver, bronze

JURY:

A Competition Jury will be appointed. A decision by the Competition Jury is final.

FIREARMS & AMMUNITION STORAGE:

There will be no overnight firearms or ammunition storage at the range.

All firearms must be transported, unloaded and in a case, that completely encloses the firearm. The case shall be designed for transportation of firearms and in a secured condition when transporting firearms. All ammunition shall be stored in a separate container. All firearms must have an empty chamber indicator in the chamber at all times unless on the firing line and permission is granted to remove empty chamber indicator.

The Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity form **MUST** be attached to the match entry form when submitted to the Minneapolis Rifle Club prior to the event. Both forms are attached to the bottom of this form.

AMMUNITION:

Ammunition will not be for sale at this event.

LODGING:

At this time, there are no hotels/ motels with discounted rates available. Should any be added for this match we will update on <https://300meternationals.org/>. The nearest city with lodging is Elk River, Minnesota (USA).

EQUIPMENT CHECK:

There will be a formal equipment check for this event. All athletes must adhere to all standards within the published rules. Spot checks will be performed during the match.

COURSES OF FIRE:

All courses of fire will be as prescribed by ISSF Rules. All shooters will shoot each course of fire twice on separate days. 3 - Position Men and Women's will require 120 total shots for record (each 60-shot match in 90 minutes), Standard Rifle will require 120 total shots for record (each 60-shot match in 120 minutes) and Prone will require 120 total shots for record (each 60-shot match in 50 minutes). Bring sufficient ammunition for the course of fire and sighters/practice ammunition to meet your own requirements. **Note: Women are welcome and encouraged to shoot Standard Rifle as they are now eligible for team selection.**

SQUADDING:

All Squadding will be by random drawing. Firing position and relay will be determined by the drawing.

SUBJECT TO CHANGE:

Please keep in mind that the match schedule and squadding are subject to change. Although we make every attempt to maintain the published schedule, target malfunctions, weather and other items are out of our control. It is the responsibility of the competitors and/or coaches to check the schedule and squadding daily and most importantly in the evening. CODE OF CONDUCT:

By registering for this competition, you are agreeing to abide by the USA Shooting Code of Conduct both on and off the range complex for the duration of the event. As a participant, you are representing our sport and organization. Providing an example of good conduct, appearance and sportsmanship is paramount. The Code of Conduct is available on the USAS website

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

The Men's and Women's 3x20 3-Position will be limited to 28 total competitors. The Men's prone match is limited to 28 competitors. Women's Prone and Standard Rifle is limited to 14 competitors each. MRC reserves the right to increase the maximum capacity by adding relays and amending the schedule if deemed necessary and feasible. Seniors may use a lens not exceeding 1.5 power per USA Shooting Rule 4.4. Seniors using a lens are not eligible for Selection for World Championships, Finals or National Records.

COVID: any COVID protocols mandated by the US Federal Government or State of Minnesota will be followed.

EQUIPMENT CHECK:

There will be a formal equipment check for this event. All athletes must adhere to all standards within the published rules. Spot checks will be performed during the match.

FINALS:

Finals will not be conducted. This is not an Olympic Qualification event. In events, ties will be broken per the ISSF rules (number of inter-tens, etc.) to determine the Winner.
