

# **FAST LANE MOTORSPORTS ASSOCIATION (FLMA)**

## **BYLAWS**

### **ARTICLE I — NAME & PURPOSE**

#### **Section 1. Name**

The name of this organization shall be the **Fast Lane Motorsports Association (FLMA)**.

#### **Section 2. Purpose**

FLMA is established to support, promote, and grow the motorsports community by providing:

- A structured membership program
- Resources for drivers, teams, and partners
- Professional development tools
- Networking and promotional opportunities
- A centralized hub for motorsports information and engagement

FLMA operates as a community-focused association dedicated to accessibility, professionalism, and growth within all levels of racing.

### **ARTICLE II — MEMBERSHIP**

#### **Section 1. Eligibility**

Membership is open to:

- Drivers
- Teams
- Crew members
- Industry professionals
- Businesses and brand partners
- Fans and supporters

All members must agree to uphold FLMA's values, conduct expectations, and community standards.

## **Section 2. Membership Categories**

FLMA may offer multiple membership types, including but not limited to:

- Driver Membership
- Team Membership
- Business/Partner Membership
- Supporter Membership

Membership categories and benefits may be updated as the association grows.

## **Section 3. Dues**

Membership dues shall be set by FLMA leadership and may be adjusted as needed. Dues must be paid annually to maintain active membership status.

## **Section 4. Rights & Benefits**

Active members may receive:

- Access to FLMA resources and tools
- Visibility on the FLMA website and social platforms
- Eligibility for programs, features, and promotions
- Discounts or perks from participating partners

## **Section 5. Termination of Membership**

Membership may be suspended or revoked for:

- Violations of conduct
- Failure to pay dues

- Misrepresentation of affiliation

## **ARTICLE III — GOVERNANCE**

### **President:**

### **Vice President (if applicable):**

- Assists the President
- Oversees programs and membership

### **Directors/Coordinators:**

- Manage specific areas such as membership, partnerships, media, or events

## **Section 3. Meetings**

Leadership meetings shall be held as needed to conduct business.

Special meetings may be called by the President.

## **ARTICLE IV — CODE OF CONDUCT**

### **Section 1. Member Expectations**

All members must:

- Conduct themselves professionally
- Treat others with respect
- Uphold sportsmanship on and off the track
- Represent FLMA positively
- Follow safety guidelines and track rules

## **Section 2. Prohibited Conduct**

The following may result in disciplinary action:

- Harassment or discrimination
- Unsportsmanlike behavior
- Fraud or misrepresentation
- Abuse of FLMA resources
- Actions damaging to the association's reputation

## **ARTICLE V — PARTNERSHIPS & BUSINESS MEMBERS**

### **Section 1. Eligibility**

Businesses offering products, services, or support to the motorsports community may become partners.

### **Section 2. Partnership Levels**

FLMA may offer multiple partnership tiers with varying benefits. Discount-offering partners may receive reduced rates at FLMA's discretion.

### **Section 3. Promotion & Visibility**

Partners may be featured on:

- The FLMA website
- Social media pages
- Promotional materials
- Member resources

FLMA reserves the right to approve or deny partner content.

## **ARTICLE VI — AMENDMENTS**

### **Section 1. Amendments to Bylaws**

These bylaws may be amended by FLMA leadership as needed to support growth, structure, and operational needs.

### **Section 2. Notification**

Members will be notified of major changes through official FLMA communication channels.

## **ARTICLE VII — Membership Discretion Clause**

The President, Vice President and/or Directors of the Fast Lane Motorsports Association reserves the right to refuse, revoke, or deny membership to any individual, team, or entity at any time and for any reason, with or without explanation. This authority is final and not subject to appeal.
