

## Counting On - Adding Onto 5

### Materials:

1. Scissors
2. \$1 and \$5 printables

### Procedure:

1. Have your child cut out money.

### Play:

Have your child use the money during pretend play.

### Optional Games:

#### Game 1

1. Play a game where you lay out money in different amounts: \$5 and \$1, \$5 and two \$1s, \$5 and three \$1s.
2. Have your child practice counting the money, starting with the \$5.
3. Have your child use language such as, "5 and 1 more is 6" or "5, 6, 7 that's 7 dollars!"

#### Game 2

1. Give your child one \$5 and four \$1s.
2. Ask your child to give 6, 7, or 8 dollars, make sure your child understands to start with the largest number.
