Counting On - Adding Onto 5

Materials:

- 1. Scissors
- 2. \$1 and \$5 printables

Procedure:

1. Have your child cut out money.

Play:

Have your child use the money during pretend play.

Optional Games:

Game 1

- 1. Play a game where you lay out money in different amounts: \$5 and \$1, \$5 and two \$1s, \$5 and three \$1s.
- 2. Have your child practice counting the money, starting with the \$5.
- 3. Have your child use language such as, "5 and 1 more is 6" or "5, 6, 7 that's 7 dollars!"

Game 2

- 1. Give your child one \$5 and four \$1s.
- 2. Ask your child to give 6, 7, or 8 dollars, make sure your child understands to start with the largest number.

Accommodations:

If your child struggles, return to the game <u>At The Restaurant</u>. Have your child use the printable money while playing the game.
