

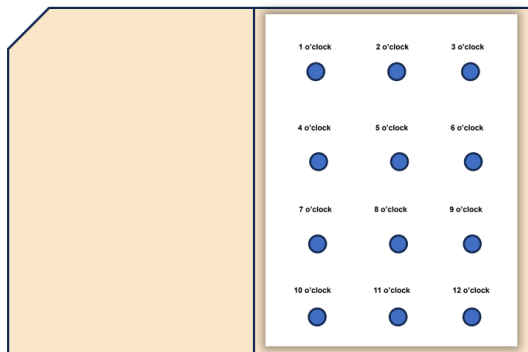
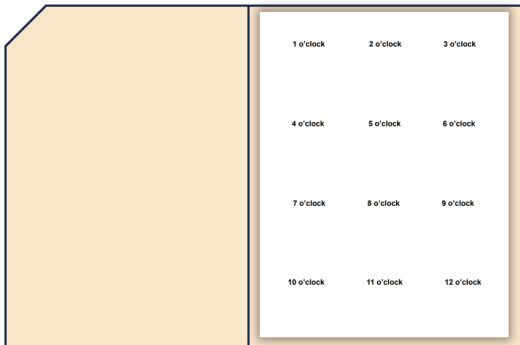
## **Adult Directions: Making a File Folder Game**

### **Materials:**

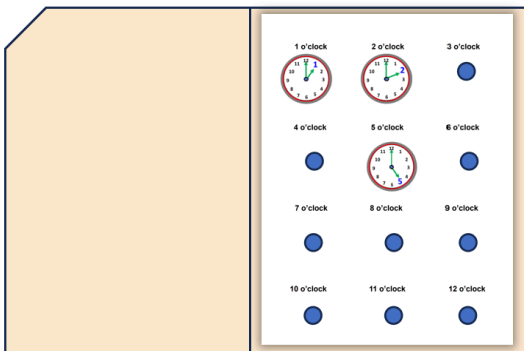
1. Print out page 2 and 3 of the document.

6. Cover with contact paper or laminate to make the game last through multiple plays.
7. Cut out clock faces from the Watches page and cover in contact paper or laminate
8. Place velcro in spaces below words listing the times.

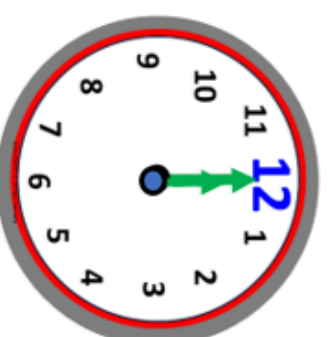
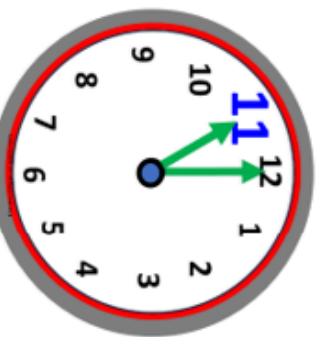
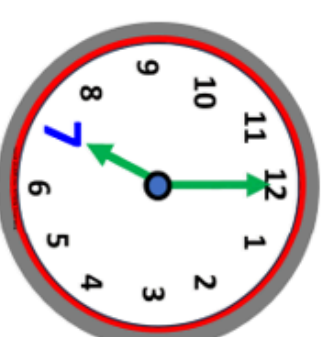
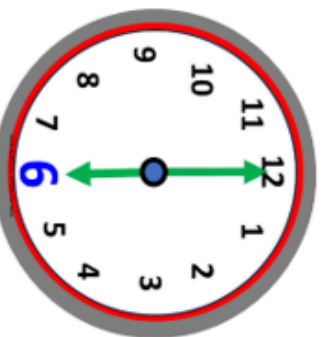
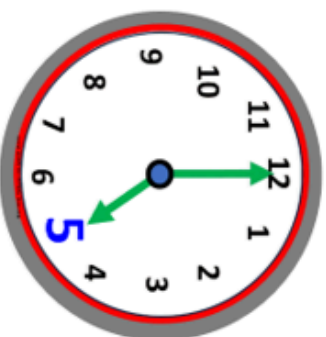
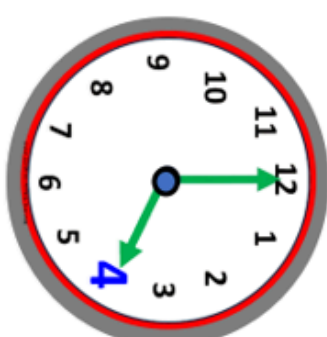
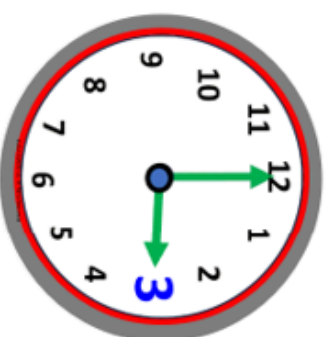
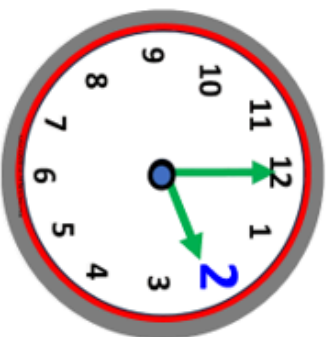
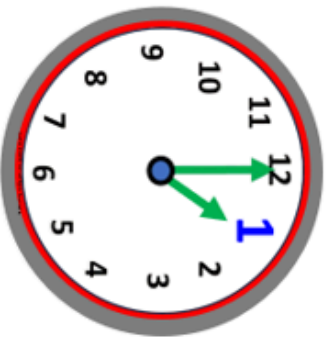


9. Place velcro on the back of each clock.
