Invasive plant species most commonly dealt with on Prince Edward Island will be introduced. Information on how to identify these plants visually will be given, along with protocols for reporting, irradiation, removal and disposal. Chase and Clay will highlight some of the invasive species of insects currently facing Islanders, such as Japanese Beetle. As well, insect pests that may present a problem on PEI in the future will be identified through pictures and physical examples, where possible. These include Ash Borer, Hemlock Woolly Adelgid, and Invasive Box Tree Moth.

1 – 3pm **Gary Schneider, MacPhail Woods**

An overview of the identification and preferred habitats of the various species of trees that make up the original Acadian Forest will be outlined. Gary will also explain what constitutes our present forests in the Maritimes and how we can support and transition back to more diverse plantings of trees suited to the environment. He will also address the use of native trees in the urban landscape where conditions can support their growth. Visual images of many of the native species will be provided as a way to familiarize the audience with the identification of native plants of PEI.
