RULES for the Awards of Excellence Program

- Must be a member in good standing at time of entry.
- IMPORTANT: Each project can only be entered in a maximum of two (2) categories, once in the Presentation category group and again in any one Specialty category. (* please note that where a dollar value is attached to the category, a project may not be divided into smaller components to be entered into a lesser category)
- LNB member companies may enter any project completed by their company past, or present and may enter the same project every other year, provided new photos are taken and a new description written
- Once a project has successfully won an award, it cannot be re-entered, with the exception of construction projects which move forward to a maintenance category.
- No entries will be accepted after midnight Jan 31, 2023 deadline.
- The scoring guidelines provided by the CNLA require a minimum score of 75% before a project submitted can receive an award. The entry with the highest points above this threshold, as determined by the judges will be deemed the winner, and will be recognized in the Association's and CNLA publications and website where appropriate.
- 3 winning entries will be submitted to the National Awards of Excellence. (please specify if you do not wish your entry to be forwarded to this next level) Although you can enter and win in the provincial awards for any work that you have done, national awards regulations do not allow for the member's property to be eligible.

ENTRY DEADLINE: January 31, 2023- No entries will be accepted after the Jan. 31th deadline

Checklist

For each submission you must provide:

- A completed **entry form**
- Letter of **permission to submit**, signed and dated by client.
- A clear **description of the project** in 500 words or less
- A clear indication of any project components not done by you.
- A minimum of 10, maximum of 20 **digital (jpeg format) photos**, may also include video, numbered in order of viewing by judges. Highlight before, during and after for construction entries.
- **Image description list** (numbers corresponding with images, highlight one image for awards.
- If submitting a maintenance entry, indicate the **time you have been maintaining** the property
(i.e. - Spring 2019-present)
- Any **drawings** related to the project (all design drawings must be in PDF format)
- **Budget and timeline**

Design Award Special Instruction

ENTRY CHECKLIST

The following should be included with entry:

1. Statement of the Design Intent (75 words max.)	
• Conditions set out by the client	
• Design theme selected to meet the client's needs	
2. Project Description (250 words max.)	
• Overall Scope	
• hardiness zone	
• existing site conditions	
• description of process, design	
• resolution of challenges, etc.	
• Explanation of special features: structural or specimen plantings	
• Environmental responsibility measures taken	
3. Landscape Plans	
• A full set of design plans to scale, must include the following:	
• title block showing client name, site address, scale, north arrow, and date	
• grading and drainage (existing and proposed)	
• hardscape and softscape materials (plant masses may be labeled as group)	
• plant list (either on the landscape plan or on a separate list) including common and botanical names, quantities, size and condition of woody and herbaceous plants	
• layout and dimension plan	
• construction details (including elevations and cross sections)	
• other sketches/drawings may also be included, if necessary to illustrate the project	
4. Digital Images	
• No less than 10 and no more than 30 color images
