Provider Overview

Empowering Futures is an established Alternative Provision and training organisation (founded 2015), supporting young people and adults who are unable to access mainstream education due to SEND, SEMH needs, EBSA, exclusion risk or disrupted education.

Our Birmingham provision delivers structured vocational pathways within a regulated, calm and supportive environment, with clear routines, relationship-led practice and strong safeguarding oversight.

Maths, English and Digital Skills are embedded across all programmes through contextualised functional learning.

Secondary Alternative Provision (Ages 11–16)

A supportive, vocationally-led learning environment for learners disengaged from mainstream education or on reduced timetables, with a focus on re-engagement, emotional regulation, confidence and preparation for post-16 destinations.

Delivery Model:

- Small group delivery (2–6 learners)
- Individualised timetables
- Blended core and vocational learning
- Trauma-informed staffing and routines
