What: Cartwheel-A-Thon (100% Profit goes toward Warrior Whit Benefit)

Where: Putnam County Fairgrounds, 118 Fairgrounds Rd., East Palatka, FL 32131

When: April 16th, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. (Saturday) Sign up for your preferred time slot.

Can't make the event date – keep reading because we have provided a way to include everyone.

All gymnasts of all ages are encouraged to participate! Rolls will count as cartwheels!

Win: The person who raises the most funds will get a FREE private lesson from Miss Michel and they can bring a friend (no enrollment required).

How: Below are steps to start our Cartwheel-A-Thon for Warrior Whit

1. Set goals: Gymnast should make a goal based on how many cartwheels (rolls) they think they can complete in 2 minutes. Parents should start practicing this with their child now!
2. Gymnast should also set a financial goal to reach for the benefit.
3. Get pledges: Take pledge form to families, friends, businesses. Share our event on all your social media and not have to worry about collecting money – it can be done all online through many of USAGA online payment methods listed below.

*****Ask for flat donations or pledge per cartwheel completed within 2minutes.

(Ex: Sally gives Amanda € .50/cartwheel, or a flat \$50 dollars for 100 cartwheels completed). Please make your minimum flat donation \$5 or more. This is going towards a great benefit in our local community.

****Do Cartwheels: On April 16th, 2023. USA Gymnastics Academy will allow 2 minutes for the gymnast to complete as many cartwheels (rolls) as they can, in attempt to reach their pledge goal or even beat it.

CAN'T MAKE THE ACTUAL EVENT: Gymnasts may cartwheel or roll by video recordings and put it out on your social media if they cannot make the event date. The student's video will then need to be shared on our USA Gymnastics Academy Facebook page to show Warrior Whit and their family your support.

Finally: Go Collect! After completing their cartwheel-a-thon record, the gymnast must collect the pledge if it was based on the number of their cartwheels in their challenge or any final donations.
