REHEARSAL – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

USAGA parents of performing students will need to purchase recital tickets in advance before the show. Tickets will be available for purchase at the front desk at USAGA starting Monday, May 20th up until rehearsal evening (\$5 each). All other family members and guests may purchase advance tickets or at the door on show day.

Individual Photos will be taken during rehearsal (optional!) Our photographer will be set up at the auditorium for those parents wanting their child’s picture taken in costume. Time slots and photo prices will be available soon. Students will need to change into regular gym clothes before rehearsing! ***NO COSTUMES will be allowed on stage during rehearsal!!***

Rehearsal is not a dress rehearsal! Students come to rehearse in appropriate clothing with hair up

- **NO KIDS UP IN BALCONY!**
- CHECK IN AT CLASS REHEARSAL TABLE AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE & SELF STRETCH
- During Rehearsal, please check for your child’s name spelling and listing on the program (if an error) your family will be made new programs ASAP for keepsake.
- Familiarize yourself with Band Room, Bathrooms, etc. at Auditorium
- Tickets will be available for Pre-Sale during Rehearsal at table in front of stage!
- Parents/guardians & family do pay admission to the show on Saturday – only performing student is FREE
- DVD’s can be now or at rehearsal - \$20 (cash, check or charge) must be pd in advance for order! Blue Ray and USBs are also available for \$25

RECITAL – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW – NO KIDS UP IN BALCONY unless with parent

- ALL students need a button or zip-up cover over worn inside over the costume upon arrival of Auditorium and left on when inside audience.
- All students need to be completely ready for stage (makeup, hair, glitter, etc.)
- Students need to wear shoes at all times until they go on stage. NO DIRTY FEET!
- CHECK IN FOR RECITAL IS AT **1 PM** (Look for RECITAL CHECK IN TABLE) in Breezeway by Band Room
- Everyone should be checked in no later than 1:30 p.m. and no one back stage at all!! This includes parents, older students, etc. (only instructors and stage help are to be backstage!) If **URGENT** question-Ask to see Jessica or Michel
- Pictures can be taken outside, but cover-up must be worn until outside of Auditorium (***stage will be available for pictures after recital is over***)
- Routines 1 & 2 need to be checked into Band Room by **1:45 p.m. Use Breezeway** as entrance and exit. DO NOT walk back stage!
- Parents need to assist their child in doing basic stretches before reporting to Band Room. There will be mats outside in Breezeway for warming up.
- Routines 3 – 15: Walk your child to the Band Room **2 ROUTINES** in advance of their #– please **ONLY** do this during curtain closures or routine endings! **Use Breezeway!**
- Do not get up and leave Auditorium in the middle of a routine – please wait for ending.
- We are asking everyone to stay for the entire performance – ALL STUDENTS ARE BEING PRESENTED SOMETHING SPECIAL at the Finale.
- All students need to return to the band room by number **13** to be part of this Finale.
- No students or parents back stage unless you have been selected as a volunteer OR have a child in Mon 5:30 class performing.
- No reserving seats during rehearsal – all will be removed prior to 1 pm on Saturday.
- Please remember to throw trash away after the recital. We rent the Auditorium and will be charged additional fees if left a mess.
