CHANGE YOUR SPOT

In the Old Testament, Jeremiah becomes so disgusted with his people's unfaithfulness and idolatry that he almost believes they can't change. He wonders whether a leopard can change its spots. When a Sunday school teacher posed that question, one student pondered before replying, "Yes ... If he doesn't like the spot he's in, he can change it."

Jeremiah reached a similar conclusion: Hi s people could change their evil ways — their "spots" — if they chose to. "You can do good who are accustomed to do evil," he says (Jeremiah 13:23, NRSV). As another prophet later notes, God has shown us "what is good … To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God" (Micah 6:8, NIV). What spot — or spots — can you change?

Love In the Name of Christ is a church-based ministry that began in 1977 in Holland, Michigan.

Its founding vision was to become a tool to help Christian churches become more engaged with their neighbors who had needs. Love INC was designed to inspire a more Christians to put their faith into action.

Love INC helps churches help people. It teaches churches how to assess their capabilities, connect with their neighbors, build new ministries and find fulfilled volunteers, and serve their community. It also unites a variety of congregations in a single purpose of serving so that, working together, all churches can more effectively offer real help to their neighbors.

A Matter Of First Resort

When King Jehoshaphat of Judah got word that neighboring peoples were on their way to attack his nation, 2 Chronicles 20:3 (NRSV) tells us he "was afraid [and] set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah."

The Message paraphrase of the Bible is even more direct: "Shaken, Jehoshaphat prayed. He went to GOD for help and ordered a nationwide fast." We get the sense that the king prays immediately after hearing the bad news.

Often we pray as a last resort, not a first one. This ancient monarch reminds us to consult God before doing anything else — in times of trouble as well as celebration. God preserved Jehoshaphat and will surely provide and care for us.
