Join The Salvation Ride on Saturday, July 11, and help support The Salvation Army's homeless shelter in

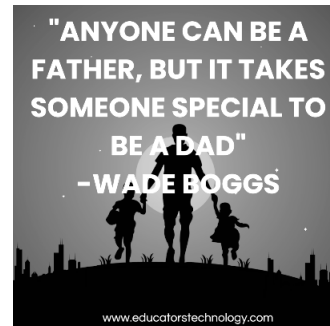
