

OUR HOME CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES

Our Home Christian Ministries provides a loving Christian family home environment for the adults with disabilities who are residing there. In providing nurturing quality care to these adults, Our Home strives to radiate God's love to the Oostburg community. The resident manager and staff of Our Home have the unique privilege of building an extended family of God's people who can grow together in love for each other and for God.

Our Home Christian Ministries began in 1998 with a vision of a Christian adult family home for adults with developmental disabilities. This vision became a reality in September of 1999 when a house was donated and renovated in Oostburg as a state-licensed adult family home for four residents and a house-parent family. In April 2003, Our Home branched out with Our Home Apartments. In June 2005 Our Home opened a third place of residence, and in February 2012 a fourth home opened. Area churches, businesses, individuals, and the residents themselves all contribute financial support to Our Home.

Holly was first used by pagans to decorate for the festival of Saturnalia. When Christians began celebrating Christmas in honor of Christ, they adapted that decorating practice to reflect Jesus' life and death. Holly's pointed leaves symbolize the crown of thorns and its red berries symbolize Christ's blood shed on the cross. Because holly thrives and its berries retain their brilliance even in harsh winter conditions, non-Christians saw it as a symbol of eternity — which is fitting for Christians as well.
