

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY – BURN BAN HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED

THE CITY OF PLANTERSVILLE HAS ESTABLISHED IMMEDIATELY, AS OF WEDNESDAY, MARCH 19, 2025, AT EMERGENCY MEETING A BURN BAN THAT IS FOR ALL CITIZENS IN THE CITY LIMITS OF PLANTERSVILLE, TEXAS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND WELFARE BY OUTDOOR BURNING.

ALL OUTDOOR BURNING IS PROHIBITED IN THE CITY LIMITS UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

WHEREAS THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN HAVE ESTABLISHED THIS BURN BAN IN ALL OR PART OF THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY OF PLANTERSVILLE, TEXAS.

THIS APPLIES TO ALL OUTDOOR BURNING – INDIVIDUALS, BUSINESSES, CONTRACTORS AND OTHERS. THE FIRE HAZARDS ARE INCREASING AND ADDITIONAL WEATHER ACTIVITIES INDICATE THE RISK FOR UNCONTROLLED AND/OR CONTROLLED BURNS NECESSITATES IMMEDIATE ACTION, THE BURN BAN IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY FROM AND AFTER THE DATE OF THIS NOTICE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL CODE SECTION 352.018, A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CLASS C MISDEMEANOR, EACH OFFENSE IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00.
