

City of Plantersville roads are, as they always have been, maintained by Grimes County Road & Bridge (GCR&B). This is done through an Interlocal Agreement between the city and the county. This is standard procedure throughout all incorporated cities in Grimes County. The change since the incorporation of the city is the request must first be made to the city representative.

The City of Plantersville does have funds allocated in the city budget for road materials.

CITY OF PLANTERSVILLE PROCEDURE TO REQUEST ROAD MAINTENANCE/REPAIRS

1. Requests for road maintenance/repairs should be addressed to Mayor Karen Hale; submitted through the city website, my city email (khaleplantersville@gmail.com), or by calling my personal number (713-851-8304). Any request calls for maintenance/repairs that are made to GCR&B are directed to the mayor, as the city representative. Texas Statutes do not recognize social media platforms as permissible forms of communication for requests; therefore, all requests must be made through the above-mentioned methods.
2. Requests should state the requester's name, the road for which the repair is requested, the nature of the problem, and the specific location on the road.
3. The mayor drives to the location, looks for the conditions for which the citizen has made requests (as the mayor is not a road engineer, the mayor does not decide if the road is in need of repair/maintenance or what work might need to be done). The mayor takes pictures and sends them to GCR&B.
4. GCR&B decides what needs to be done to repair the problem cited and emails a proposal to the mayor for approval of the cost required to repair. The city is responsible for the expense of the materials required and the county furnishes the labor.
5. Work is scheduled at the discretion of GCR&B.
