A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PLANTERSVILLE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING CITY REPRESENTATIVES IN MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM 2025-2026.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Plantersville desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Plantersville to participate in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Plantersville is committed to compliance with federal, state, and program rules, including the current TxCDBG Project Implementation Manual; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF PLANTERSVILLE, TEXAS:

That the Board of Aldermen directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with any grant application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program:

- The Mayor, Kimberly Allphin and Mayor Pro Tem, John Greenwood shall serve as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to
 - execute a grant application and any subsequent contractual documents,
 - certify environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the City, and
 - certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs, and
 - be assigned the role of Authorized Official in the TDA-GO grant management system.
- In addition to the above designated officials, should any grant be funded, the Grant Secretary is authorized to
 - certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs,
 - prepare and submit other financial documentation, and
 - be assigned the role of Project Director or Payment Processor in the TDA-GO grant management system.
