3. Public Hearing on Proposed City Budget for Fiscal Year beginning 10-1-2020 through 09-30-2021. Mayor Hale proceeded with the Public Budget Hearing for the City of Plantersville on the proposed Budget for Fiscal Year beginning 10-1-2020 through 09-30-2021. Postings were made in the Bryan Eagle and Navasota Examiner, on the City official bulletin board and the City website in accordance with state requirements. Posting was also made on City Facebook page, DP Water Office and the Plantersville U.S. Post Office. There is no tax rate as the City of Plantersville has No Property Taxes at this time. This statement is a required part of the City Budget each year in compliance with the State Code. Mayor Hale reviewed that there is no city property tax and there is no intent to add a city property tax.

Mayor Hale reviewed the proposed City Budget.

Alderman Dean requested a line item of \$100,000 be added to the proposed budget for proposed property purchase and facilities for the City of Plantersville with a City Hall.

The Board agreed this was reasonable and are in favor of adding the line item as proposed by Alderman Dean upon formal motion in the Regular Meeting immediately after this Hearing.

4. Action on Proposed Budget: Alderman Bettes made the motion to postpone the final vote on the Proposed General Budget for the City of Plantersville until the regularly scheduled meeting that will commence at 7 p.m. Alderman Mayton seconded the motion. Motion carried.
