- Discuss/consider/approve: discussion of 2025-2026 Texas Community Development Fund Grant, CDBG Program of Texas Department of Agriculture location possibilities:

 Discussion: Steve Duncan with Bleyl Engineering was present to describe the location possibilities that fit the requirement by DOA for the grant. There are 2 main locations that fit the requirement: CR 311 and CR 203, with CR 203 in the greatest need for improvements. Mr. Duncan brought maps for each Alderman. He showed us the scope of the project that he recommends. He mentioned that CR 311 is already up for some fairly major work. Mayor Hale said that Grimes County Road & Bridge will soon be fixing the culvert situation at the curve on the creek and will overlay a long section of CR 311 starting at the far end and going toward SH 105. The materials will not reach SH 105, but the Mayor has asked for a quote on what the materials to finish the overlay on the road to SH 105 would be so that the City can possibly pay for those materials and have all of CR 311 in good shape. Mr. Duncan answered a few questions.
