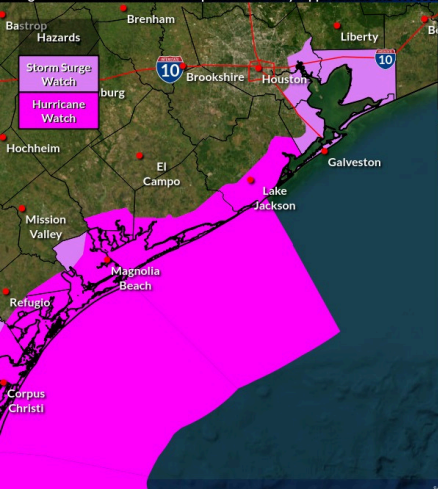


TS Beryl Marine Hazards

HURRICANE WATCH

Sustained winds of 64 knots (74 mph) are possible

STORM SURGE WATCH

- Some beach access will be impassable
- Do not cross barricades
- Protect flood-prone property

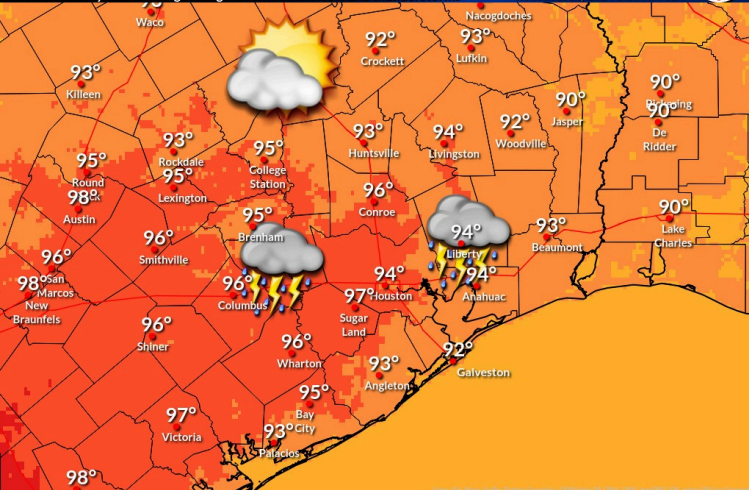
