year and what transpired within our assembly. We had a great year and I want to thank all of our Sir Knights for their dedication and service to the Assembly. You all make this job easy. I also want to acknowledge the help and support of all our Clergy. Thank you for your continued support. You are always in our prayers.

As we all know when I took office on July 1 of 2023, the assembly was basically on life support. There were no meetings being held and the Assembly basically only existed on paper.

The first thing we did, I asked Sir Knight Ralph Mitchell Jr to take over media communications for the Assembly and he has shined in service. The Former Master said we had one of the best communication newsletters and media systems in the state, if not the best.

In the last year we increased the membership by more then 10%. We went from no uniforms to 7, transferred from A J Caillouet Assembly, 5 new uniforms purchased, for a total of 12 Sir Knights capable of dressing out. We currently stand at 14.

We initiated several Civic and Patriotic Programs and have been a blessing in service to the clergy, Veterans and our parishioners when called upon.

Sir Knights our efforts have not gone unnoticed. We achieved the highest level of recognition from Supreme Council the "Star Assembly Award" and it should be presented to us soon. This is no small accomplishment for a struggling Assembly.

And then came September. As FN, I was presented the award by the Former District Master on September 7th, for Assembly of the year for the District of Louisiana Jurisdiction. We are the best Assembly in the State. This was not an I thing, but a "We Thing" credited to the efforts of the entire Assembly. I wish they would present these awards to the Assembly but the way it is done it is presented in the name of the FN. All I did was have the drive and desire to inspire a group of Catholic Men to make a stand and work towards common goals for the good of our Faith, Church and Order. This is truly a testament to the character of each Sir Knight in our Assembly. Job well done Gentlemen.
