

S.L.P.O.A. MAIN BEACH RULES - 2021

1. BADGES MUST BE DISPLAYED TO ENTER THE BEACH. All members must check in at main entrance. Only members may use badges. SLPOA guests may not be people who live within the SLPOA boundaries who are eligible to join Skyline Lakes.
2. A member bringing guests must accompany their guests to the main entrance. All guests must be checked in. Please see new guest pass procedures on next page. *Anyone eligible to join S.L.P.O.A. cannot be a guest.* Guest tags are meant to be short term meaning *the same person may not visit as a guest on a regular basis throughout the summer.* Any member or guest not cooperating or following the beach rules will be asked to leave.
3. CHILDREN under 12 YEARS OLD MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES ON THE BEACH AND IN THE WATER BY AN ADULT OR SOMEONE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD. LIFEGUARDS CANNOT BABY-SIT YOUR CHILDREN.
4. NO GLASS OF ANY KIND IS ALLOWED ON THE BEACH. Coolers/bags will be inspected at the gate. SLPOA reserves the right to confiscate any glass or refuse entry.
5. All members and their guests are responsible for this beach. Please clean up any trash or recyclables before leaving. We are not responsible for personal items left on the beach. Anything left on the beach will be disposed of at the end of the day.
6. No dogs or other pets allowed on the beach at any time.
7. Anyone deemed unruly will be ejected from the beach area at the discretion of the Beach Director, Lifeguards, or any representative of the Association.
8. No ball playing, horseplay, or running on the beach when lifeguards are on duty. Games *can* be played in areas designated by the lifeguard.
9. No swimmer, no matter how skilled, is allowed beyond the supervised area.
10. Parents may not take non-swimmers past the first rope.
11. *Parents are required to watch their children in the water.* Parents should determine how far out in the deep water their children can swim and instruct accordingly. Lifeguards and SLPOA personnel reserve the right to amend such instructions at any time.
12. Any member or guest reported interfering with the duties of the LIFEGUARDS or acting in an inappropriate behavior will be asked to leave and their Beach privileges will be suspended.
13. No pushing off the raft. Lifeguards have the right to remove your child from the water due to any disciplinary reasons.
14. Fins and masks are not to be used beyond the second rope. No floating devices, rafts, tubes, etc. are allowed past the second rope, no matter how experienced the swimmer.
15. Lifeguards have the final say in the use of the Water Trampoline. Due to safety considerations, no more than 4 to 6 people (depending on size and weight) may be on the trampoline at one time.
16. Only one person is allowed on the water slide at a time. No jumping allowed from the slide.
17. No fishing allowed from sand or swim areas at any time.
18. No boats, except lifeguard boat allowed in the swimming area.

19. Barbecue area and grills are to be cleaned after use.
20. Lifeguards are on duty daily 10:30 am – 6:00pm (7pm in July) unless otherwise posted.
21. Smoking in designated areas only! No smoking on the sand beach. This includes cigars, cigarettes and e-cigarettes.
22. The use of large flotation devices such as tubes or rafts may not be used within the swimming area. Use of these devices may only be permitted outside of any designated swimming area.

Please note our Liability Insurance *does not* cover any injuries or accidents resulting from the consumption of alcoholic beverages; you do so entirely at your own risk. In addition, SLPOA lifeguards are our employees, and most are minors; it is our *obligation* to provide a safe, proper work environment for them. While we are not banning alcoholic beverages from the beach at this time, we ask that if you must bring adult beverages onto the beach please be discreet. Also, alcoholic beverages are to be kept at least 15 feet away from the lifeguard stands and away from the waters edge, preferably towards the back of the beach or in the picnic area.
