What is IP-3?

If proponents successfully gather enough signatures to qualify to be on Oregon's 2024 general election ballot, IP-3 (Initiative Petition 3) will ask voters to make **killing animals in Oregon illegal**.

Consequently, this proposal would change animal abuse statutes to **criminalize hunting, fishing, trapping, killing animals** for food, education and research purposes, wildlife management practices, and even trapping mice and vermin. It would also **classify breeding animals to include domestic pets, livestock, and equine, as sexual assault**

The passage of IP-3 would create a "no kill" sanctuary state forcing Oregonians to a vegan lifestyle or to have their meat and dairy shipped in from other states, making us increasingly more reliant on the national food network for our food resources.
