Early Headstart students: Uniform is not mandatory, but highly recommended for the following reasons: encourages discipline, sense of equality, promotes learning, heightens school pride, and Safety-wise, uniforms make students easily identifiable.



Velcro straps preferred.

General Regulations

- No make-up, or artificial nails.
- No temporary tattoos.
- Only a small religious medal or cross on a thin chain may be worn. No cord style chains allowed.
- No bracelets are to be worn, unless for medical identification.
- No rings are to be worn.

• Earrings: Girls- One pair of plain small stud earrings for pierced ears on the lower lobe is permitted. No dangling or hoop earrings are allowed. Boys-No earrings are permitted.

- Sandals and Crocs are not permitted. Socks are required. Sneakers with Velcro straps are preferred.
- Students are to be properly groomed hair at all times.
- Toys from home are not permitted.

Non-Uniform Days


- Jeans are permitted.
- No spaghetti straps, backless, halter-tops, sleeveless shirts or bare midriffs are permitted.
- No flip-flops, open sandals or shoes without backs are permitted, sneakers are permitted.
- Dresses and skirts must be appropriate length
- Sneakers/Closed-toe shoes.

Cold Weather Days:

- School Sweaters Only
- On EXTREME Cold weather days, additional jackets of your choice may be worn outdoors only.
- Long-sleeve shirts worn under uniform must be white, black, or navy.

- Girls: Only ankle length leggings or tights of solid navy, white or black may be worn under the uniform in cold weather.

General Regulations

- No make-up.
- No tattoos-real or fake.
- Nails must be no more than 15mm in length. Artificial nails are not permitted.
- Hats are not permitted. Girls may wear hair ribbons or bows in school colors ONLY. Bows may not be bigger than the palm of the student's hand. (No bandanas or large hair accessories.) (Holiday bows are acceptable).
- Only a small religious medal or cross on a thin chain may be worn. No cord style chains allowed.

• No bracelets are to be worn, unless for medical identification. No pendants or good luck charms are to be worn.

- No rings are to be worn.
- The hem of the skirt must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
- Undershirts/undergarments must be white or skin-color.
- Earrings: Girls- One pair of plain small stud earrings for pierced ears on the lower lobe is permitted. No dangling or hoop earrings are allowed. Facial piercings are not permitted.

Boys-No earrings or facial piercings are permitted.

- A simple watch may be worn. Apple Watch is not permitted.
- Shirts and blouses must be tucked in during school hours and school functions.

• Socks – All students must wear plain white socks, navy or black (no logos). The length must be 1 inch above the ankles.

• Boys in seventh grade and above will be required to be clean-shaven. (Mustaches, goatees, side burns, or other trimmed facial hair are not permitted)

• Hairstyles: Properly groomed hair is required at all times. Students must keep their natural hair color. Chemically dyed, tinted, Sun-In, highlighted, etc. is not permitted. Hairstyles are subject to the approval of the administration.

Non-Uniform Days

- Jeans are permitted.
- No spaghetti straps, backless, halter-tops, sleeveless shirts or bare midriffs are permitted.
- No flip-flops, open sandals or shoes without backs are permitted.
- Dresses and skirts must be appropriate length. No shorts or dresses can be shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Sneakers/Closed-toe shoes are permitted.

NOTE: General appearance is subject to the approval of the administration.
