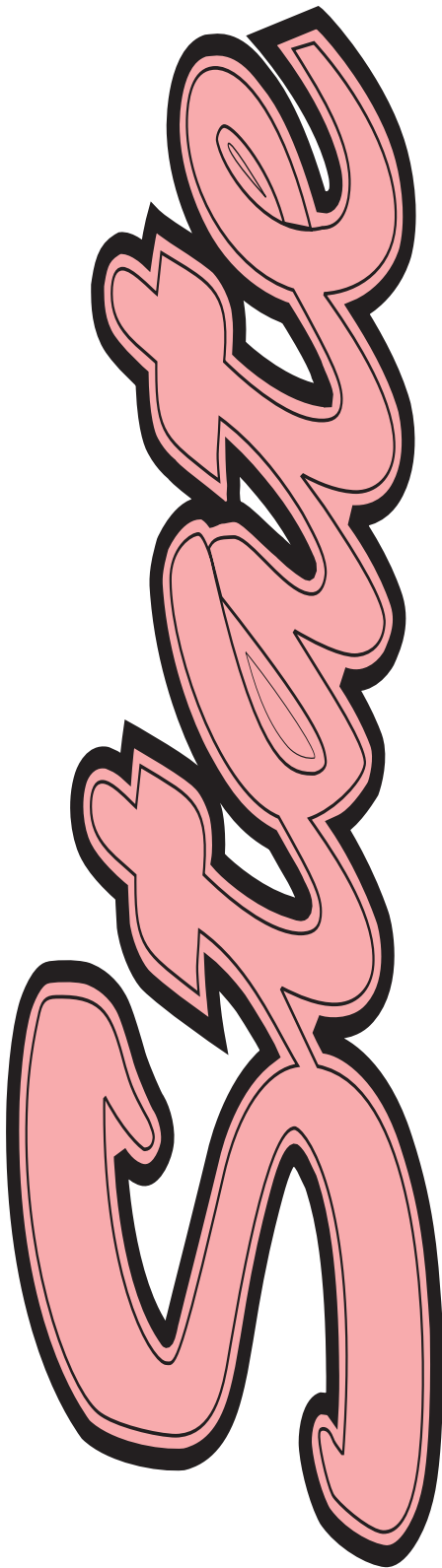

Please verify that all information is correct. Call/Email (erin@statecheer.com or judy@statecheer.com) immediately with any corrections. A final confirmation letter will be sent the week of January 27th, 2020. Last day to register and make any changes (additions to teams) is January 24th at 5:00pm. There must be three squads entered in a division for a division to compete. Head coaches will be notified by Jan 27th if a division does not make. First Registration is \$30 per participant/per entry and must be postmarked and paid by 11/30/19. 2nd Registration is \$40.00 per participant/per entry from 12/1/19 to 12/31/19. Final Registration is \$45.00 per participant/per entry from 1/1/20 to 1/24/20 at 5pm. State reserves the right to close any division at any time due to space/time limits. New registrations will not be accepted after 1/24/20. Registration Information

Registrations will not be accepted after 1/24/20 at 5:00 pm.

All deposits are totally refundable until 12/31/19. No refunds can be made after 12/31/19.

Payment in full is required for registration to be processed. Accepted payments are; hard copy Purchase Orders and checks made out to State Tournament. Credit Card payments are accepted online.

1st Registration - \$30.00 per person/per entry (postmarked by 11/30/19)

2nd Registration - \$40.00 per person/per entry (postmarked by 12/31/19)

Last Registration - \$45.00 per person/per entry (received by 1/24/20 by 5:00pm)

All Solos - \$45.00 per soloist (must enter with a team)

State reserves the right to close any division at any time due to space/time limits.

Competition Day Registration

All registered coaches and competitors must enter through the Participant Entrance. One coach **MUST** register their team during the registration time period for that team's performance and attend the coaches meeting for that session. Medical Release Forms are turned in at registration.

Coaches must be present at the door for teams to enter. You may only enter the Participation Entrance during registration times.

Performance Area

The performance area is a divided gym floor. The cheer portion is a nine-panel foam floor (54' by 42'). Dance/Pom is approximately 40'x40' Marley Dance surface. There are no out of bounds and no penalties assessed for going into another area. Cheer squads must do all stunts, pyramids and tumbling on the mats. There are no penalties for teams starting or ending a tumbling pass off the mats.

Divisions

Show Cheer: Total Routine Time Limit: 2 ½ minutes

Routine: Must include at least 1 cheer/chant, 1 dance routine, and 1 pyramid in any combination. Must follow all AACCA rules. One boy allowed.

Performance Cheer: Total Routine Time Limit: 1 ½ minutes

Routine: No music. Perform cheer/chant with transitions. Stunting and tumbling are optional. This is a JH division only.

All Girl Stunt Group (4 or 5 girls): Total Routine Time Limit: 1 minute

Routine: Music OK Stunting & Tumbling OK School Uniforms

All Boy Stunt Group (4 or 5 boys): Total Routine Time Limit: 1 minute

Routine: Music OK Stunting & Tumbling OK School Uniforms

Partner Stunt (2 only + 1 spotter): Total Routine Time Limit: 1 minute

Routine: Music OK Stunting & Tumbling OK School Uniforms

Pom: Total Routine Time Limit: 2 ½ minutes

Routine: Perform a pom routine that incorporates; 2 roll offs, 1 kick line, and 3 formation changes. Tumbling, stunting and props are not permitted – poms required. School uniforms required (no costumes).

Jazz: Total Routine Time Limit: 2 ½ minutes

Routine: A routine that demonstrates mastery of jazz style movements. Difficulty should be emphasized in creativity and originality. Appropriate costuming is permitted.

Hip Hop: Total Routine Time Limit: 2 ½ minutes

Routine: Demonstrates mastery of movement performed to appropriate street style music. Difficulty should be emphasized in body control and rhythm. Appropriate costuming is permitted.

Dance: (Includes Contemporary – Lyrical – Modern – Aerobic)

Total Routine Time Limit: 2 ½ minutes

Routine: Demonstrates mastery of style of dance performing.

Difficulty should be emphasized in originality and creativity.

Appropriate costuming is permitted. **NOTE: Junior High Schools and Junior Varsity Teams may enter this division.**

Solo:

Cheer Total Routine Time Limit: 1 minute

Dance Total Routine Time Limit: 1 minute

Safety Regulations

All schools will be following the 2019-2020 AACCA rules. All teams are required to follow State guidelines as printed in the coaches' handbook and online.

Penalties

A 10-point per team penalty (taken from final score) will be assessed for any AACCA violation. A maximum of 30 points will be levied against any one team. A 5-point penalty per team will be applied to any team going over the time allowed (2:30 + 7 seconds) for their routine or for a cheer team having a dance routine under the required 20 seconds, or a pom routine not using poms for 50% of routine. Other penalties are outlined in the Coaches Handbook and online.

Special Notes for State 2020

- ✓ All changes in numbers must be made to State 2020, by January 24th (5:00 pm). No Changes in numbers will be made after the final confirmation letter is sent the week of January 27th – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- ✓ Only the Head Coach will receive a complimentary Coaches Pass. If you would like to purchase more coaches passes, please include their names and appropriate funds (\$15.00 per coach) with your registration. Remember – only FOUR coaches/non participants will be allowed on the performance floor!
- ✓ The registration doors will only be open during the times listed under the Competition Schedule. Please make travel plans accordingly!
- ✓ Please visit our website under the Music tab for directions on how music will be played during tournament.
- ✓ **Remember – US Copyright law states, no teams are permitted to create a remix, mash-up or medley without proper written authorization from the copyright owners.**
- ✓ Individuals are welcome to compete at State 2020 in the solo division in each Session. This is a great opportunity for individuals to get extra competition experience, and seniors to have a last chance to compete etc. Please visit www.statecheer.com for more information. **Individuals must be registered with a team that is competing in other divisions.**
