Project SEEK is excited to tell you about a current Sponsorship opportunity that will benefit local elementary school students.

Project SEEK is the only local elementary school in this part of Seal Beach, and as such, we are extremely appreciative for the mutually beneficial relationship our students and their families have with our local businesses. Many of our students and their families will remain local and become the future leaders and contributors to our local community, therefore we want to ensure they have the best education possible. Arts and STEM classes are imperative to their overall education. We are hoping you will consider donating to your business' local school non-profit to help fund these classes.

Project SEEK (Seeking Excellence in Education for our Kids) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization formed in 1993 for the sole purpose of raising funds to support enrichment programs at McGaugh Elementary School in Seal Beach. At that time, state budget cutbacks threatened to end vital enrichment programs at McGaugh, such as fine art and technology. A group of parents, teachers and administrators formed Project SEEK in response, and began raising private money to fund these programs themselves. State funding has never been restored to pre-crisis levels, so Project SEEK has become a critical part of providing essential programs we all want for our children. Project SEEK is guided by an all-volunteer group of parents, faculty, and staff and enjoys a broad base of support from the local community.

Project SEEK provides funding for school enrichment programs that would otherwise not be available to McGaugh students. Current programs include: and art lab equipped with a wide array of art materials and an Art Teacher, a Media Center and computer lab, including tools to learn coding and engineering skills, an STEM Teacher (Librarian and STEM based education), and Computer Lab Aide.

Project SEEK's largest fundraiser of the year, The Event, will be held on March 27, 2026 at Old Ranch Country Club. We will host a charity dinner, a silent auction, and a live auction. Over 200 families from McGaugh attend and the function is advertised to the student body repeatedly, which is over 800 local families. It is also advertised to the local community through the fundraiser website, social media outlets, as well as the local newspaper.
