



EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT BEHAVIOR BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

Space	Expected Behavior	Consequence
Before Arriving to School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure you have your school uniform ready to wear.• Have a clear backpack and supplies ready.• Backpacks should only contain school supplies (no toys, sports equipment, trading cards, unhealthy snacks, etc.).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If the backpack is not clear, place it in Ms. Ana's office. If a student does not comply, the parent will have to pick up the backpack.• Prohibited items brought to school will be confiscated; some items might not be returned. If this behavior persists, students will not be allowed to bring backpacks to school.
During your Arrival to School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you have a Technology Agreement Form completed, turn in your devices as soon as you arrive at the gate.• If you are hungry, stop by the Cafeteria for Breakfast (8:00-8:30 AM).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• First offense: Device will be confiscated.• Second offense: Device will be confiscated and a phone call will be made home.• Third offense: Student will not be allowed to bring the device to school without a parent plan.
Water Fountain	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classrooms have water jugs that are filled daily. Students use their classroom water bottles and fill them up in class. The water bottles stay in the classroom.• Responsible students will be given the water fill-up job.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If students lose a water bottle, it will cost 'money' in their online bank account. If a student does not have enough 'money' in their account, they will need to complete community service for a replacement.• Students who are not responsible while filling the jugs will lose their jobs.
Bathroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask for permission, take a pass, and sign out. The teacher will place it on 'Hallway' Slack.• Only one student from a classroom goes at a time.• Wash hands with soap.• Throw away trash inside the bin and do not splash water on the floor.• Inform your teacher if supplies are needed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If a student does not get permission and leaves the classroom, they will get detention or owe time at recess. First time: 5 minutes, increasing by 5 minutes for each offense.• If a student makes a mess in the bathroom, they will need to complete community service. If a student refuses to complete community service, guardians will be notified and asked to support.



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Hallway/Stairwell	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Get permission and use hall pass.• Pick up/hold all trash until you reach a Trash/Recycling bin.• Respect others’ learning time by walking quietly and using an inside voice.• Respect artistic work on display by keeping your hands to yourself.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If a student does not get permission and leaves the classroom, they will get detention or owe time at recess. First time: 5 minutes, increasing by 5 minutes for each offense.• If a student is not walking quietly, respecting artistic work, or the space, they will get a warning with a reminder of expectations. If the behavior continues, students will owe time.
Hallway/Stairwell	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stay in your designated area where adults can see you.• This is the time to get water and go to the bathroom; ask for permission to go to the bathroom/get water.• No sports balls allowed in the Small Yard.• Play safely and fairly.• Line up with all of your belongings in line order when asked.• Help keep the yard clean and garbage free.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If a student does not inform an adult when leaving the space, they will have to sit out during recess or have detention.• If a student uses sports balls on the small yard, the equipment will be confiscated and the student will be given a warning the first time. If the behavior continues, students will lose privileges.• If a student does not line up when asked, they will owe time in detention or next recess for every minute the classroom is waiting.• If a student is not keeping the space clean, they will be asked to clean up and may lose privileges.
Entering Other Rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Student must be accompanied by an adult at all times, or have the appropriate hall pass, or permission from an adult. Teacher will place this information on the 'Hallway' Slack.• No food/drinks allowed.• No running or hiding in spaces.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students found in spaces unaccompanied by adults will owe 5 minutes of recess (elementary only) or detention. If the issue continues, the student will get a phone call home and lose other privileges.• Students who are not respectful of spaces will receive a warning. After the first warning, will owe community service time. If behavior continues, a plan will be set with guardians.



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Office/Lobby	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask permission or go only when sent by a staff member; obtain a pass and the teacher will place it on 'Hall' Slack.• Walk to and from the Office with a pass using a quiet voice.• Communicate your purpose or need through the Office window.• Walk into the Office only when given permission.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who are not respectful of spaces, staff, or expectations will receive a warning. After the first warning, the student will owe community service time. If behavior continues, a plan will be set with guardians.
Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students must eat and take a complete meal or bring a healthy lunch from home.• Students will raise their hands if they need something or to leave their seat.• Students will maintain a quiet noise level in the cafeteria.• Students will respect the space by throwing their trash away appropriately and cleaning their space.• Students must respect others' cultural dishes. We are a nut-free school.• Students will follow entering and leaving protocols.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If a student is disruptive in the lunchroom, they will assist in cleaning up the space and/or owe time or detention.• If a student does not clean up their own food waste, they will be asked to do community service in the cafeteria and the playground.• If students are not respectful of others' foods and continue being disrespectful after a warning, they will lose privileges, which can include eating in a separate space.
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grab all of your belongings.• Retrieve your belongings from the Lost & Found.• Report to designated dismissal spaces: cafeteria, office, or blacktop.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students' belongings left in shared spaces will be turned into the lost and found by the office. These items will get donated periodically (information will go out on Parent Square about these dates).• If students are not in designated spaces for dismissal, they will get one warning. If the problem persists, students will get a phone call home and lose privileges. If the issue continues, students will need to report to specific adults for supervision during dismissal.
