Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus declaring the order of dismissal of petitioner from service passed vide Board Resolution No.161/2 dated 12.10.2018 by the 2nd and 3rd respondents as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Principles of Natural Justice read with Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same and further direct the respondents 2 and 3 to reinstate the petitioner's services in 2nd respondent Bank

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the order of dismissal from services of petitioner in the 2nd Respondent Bank vide Board Resolution No.161/2 dated 12.10.2018 issued by the 3rd respondent herein, Pending disposal of WP 12528 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to compensate me financially from 12-10-2018 till date Rs. 75,00,000/- (Seventy-Five Lacs) for depriving me from my hard earned educational qualification certificates, lost job opportunities and Lost Livelihood, Pending disposal of WP 12528 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High court dated 15.09.2023 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Ravindhar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri T.V.S Prabhakar Rao, Counsel for respondent Nos.2 & 3, GP for Cooperation for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following

ORDER

“When the matter is posted for appearance, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the respondent/bank submitted their arguments with regard to the interim and main relief sought in the writ petition.
