What Does the Devil Know? - Part 1

It was installed in me a long time ago that the more you know about your opponent the better chance you have of defeating them. The devil knows all about our strengths and weaknesses. If we know what the devil knows we can be prepared to ward off the temptations he lays before us.

The devil knows who Jesus Christ is. Satan does not try to deny it. He confronted Him and lost. Satan used everything he had against Jesus and lost. Satan is very slick in how and what he uses on us. In Matthew 4:6 he went as far as to quote scripture to try and tempt Jesus, but Jesus did not succumb to his tricks. Satan knows there is a God and that Jesus is His Son.

The devil knows that religion is not enough. A person can be religious and still be lost. Satan knows that we will be lost if our religion does not coincide with the word of God (1 Peter 4:11; Col. 3:17). Just going to church is not what makes one a faithful follower, what makes us faithful is doing it God's way and not our own way. The Bible tells us that not everyone who thinks their religious will go to heaven (Mat. 7:21) so there must be instructions on how to get there.

The devil knows the power of the gospel. The gospel that is preached today by faithful men is the same gospel the apostles preached. The results are the same (Rom. 1:16). The gospel has the power to change men. Saul of Tarsus the "chief of sinners" (1 Tim. 1:15) was changed to the apostle Paul the "chief of Christ's servants" (1 Cor.15:10). Satan knows its power and does all he can to destroy it.

Lord willing, next week we will continue this discussion because we need to know his strengths and weaknesses so that we can defeat him. Please do not think you are immune to his tricks. If he was bold enough to try and make Christ fall, he will certainly try to bring us down.
